Holy Week

**"They gave me poison for food, and for my thirst they gave me sour wine to drink." – Psalm 69:21**

As we read the Passion narrative this weekend, we hear Jesus' final words as he fulfills the scripture verse in the Psalm and he is given sour wine to drink. Jesus then says, "It is finished." He has made the ultimate sacrifice for our sins and given us eternal life.

We have one more week before Easter. This is the last week to go and reconcile your sins. Take time to confess your sins and receive the forgiveness you need to enter Holy Week with a spiritual readiness and to gain a new sense of hope.

In two weeks we will see the new millennial saint, **Carlo Acutis**, canonized on Divine Mercy Sunday. What an exciting time! There are many new books coming out about this young saint. One of them is, *My Son Carlo: Carlo Acutis Through the Eyes of His Mother*. If you get a chance, read up on this saint. He had his second miracle recognized, and now he will be canonized on April 27, the Jubilee of Teenagers, in St. Peter's Square.

## Why Are the Statues and Crucifixes Veiled?

When the statues are veiled during these final days of Lent, we are better able to keep all of our attention on Jesus and His suffering. The veil is a form of fasting from beautiful things and reminders of heaven. It reminds us of our exile from paradise and is an image of sorrow for sin. It is also symbolic of Jesus' humiliation and of the fact that He hid His divinity during His Passion. We will remove the veils on Holy Saturday as we prepare to enter into the joy of the Vigil Mass of Easter.

## The Flowering Cross

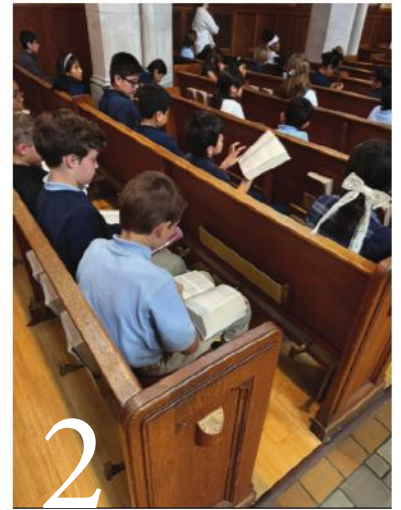


