



## The Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus



JUNE | 1 | 2025

The Catholic Church dedicates the month of June to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Catholics believe that through His heart, Jesus shares His mercy, grace, and compassion with humanity. This month we should spend time deepening our relationship with Jesus and his love for all humanity.

St. Alphonsus Ligouri and many other saints had a great devotion to the Sacred Heart. This is the prayer St. Alphonsus wrote and it was also followed by a novena.

*O Adorable heart of my Jesus, heart created expressly for the love of men! Until now I have shown towards Thee only ingratitude. Pardon me, O my Jesus. Heart of my Jesus, abyss of love and of mercy, how is it possible that I do not die of sorrow when I reflect on Thy goodness to me and my ingratitude to Thee? Thou, my Creator, after having created me, hast given Thy blood and Thy life for me; and, not content with this, Thou hast invented a means of offering Thyself up every day for me in the holy Eucharist, exposing Thyself to a thousand insults and outrages. Ah, Jesus, do Thou wound my heart with a great contrition for my sins, and a lively love for Thee. Through Thy tears and Thy blood give me the grace of perseverance in Thy fervent love until I breathe my last sigh. Amen*





## The Order of Saint Augustine

Pope Leo XIV is a member of the Order of St. Augustine, or Augustinian Order, fundamentally based upon the teachings of Jesus Christ and later of Aurelius Augustine, the Bishop of Hippo (354-430 A.D.), was founded to live and promote the spirit of community as lived by the first Christian communities (Acts of the Apostles 4, 32-35).

The Order is present in 50 different countries and numbers around 2,800 priests. As prolific missionaries, the Augustinians ventured throughout Europe, as well as to North and South America, Africa, Japan, Persia, India, and China. The Augustinians have been present in Peru — where Leo XIV spent over two decades of his ministry — since 1551.

In the United States today, there are three regional provinces of Augustinians: Philadelphia, Chicago, and San Diego. The Philadelphia province was the first, founded after Bishop John Carroll of Baltimore invited Augustinians to come over from Ireland in the 1790s.




