There is no such thing as Catholic divorce, as marriage is a permanent, unbreakable institution. Even if you think you and your spouse are beyond all reconciliation, there is hope, and there is help. Even if you are separated or civilly divorced, your marriage bond is not broken. Our clergy will either try to help you here, or guide you toward someone who can.
