### Meet Father Jones

I grew up in Kokomo, Indiana. Yea... I'm a Hoosier. Please don't hold it against me! I attended elementary school at Sts. Joan of Arc and Patrick School. I lived in my hometown with my family until I enrolled at Franciscan University in Steubenville.

It was there that I made my first Buckeye friend, my roommate, Fr. Anthony Marcelli. Between my new friends at Franciscan and my drives across the state between home and college, I slowly fell in love with that promised land called Ohio!

After college and a few years of discernment, I made the decision to settle down in southwest Ohio, join the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, and apply for seminary. I attended Mt. St. Mary's Seminary in Cincinnati and was ordained a priest on May 21, 2022. I have spent the last three years serving the good people of the NW-5 family of parishes in the northern part of the diocese, which includes Bradford, Frenchtown, Greenville, North Star, Osgood, Russia, and Versailles. I will treasure memories of my time there. The diocesan protocol for new priests is to reassign them after 2-3 years, so my time has come to move on to a new assignment. When I heard that Eastside had submitted a request for a vicar, I was excited about the opportunity and humbly submitted myself for the position. I have heard so many wonderful stories from Fr. Marcelli, and I am excited to meet the people of the parishes!




### Family of Faith




