

Our Newest Saints: Carlo and Pier Giorgio

Two young Italian laymen will be the first saints that Pope Leo XIV will canonize. The canonization of Blessed Carlo Acutis and Pier Giorgio Frassati is this Sunday, September 7. It is very exciting to see these two young men become saints. Although their lives were shortened by illness, they were great evangelists and known for their deep faith. Carlo Acutis (1991-2006) had a great love for the Eucharist. Born in London and raised in Milan, he created a website documenting Eucharistic miracles and Marian apparitions. He frequently attended Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Diagnosed with leukemia, Carlo died at the age of 15. He is entombed at Santa Maria Maggiore church in Assisi. Pier Giorgio Frassati (1901-1925) was a member of the Third Order of Saint Dominic and worked with the poor and the sick of his hometown of Turin, Italy. He contracted polio and passed away at the age of 24. We should all look to these two young saints as guides for living holy lives in our modern times.


