The reading on Thanksgiving day is the story of the lepers who come to Jesus to be healed. Jesus heals all ten of them, but only one returns to give thanks. He asks the healed leper, "Ten were cleansed, were they not? Where are the other nine?" This is a great reading for this day as it reminds us that it is always good to express gratitude.

One of the best ways to start each day is to pray and give God thanks for all that you have been given. Some days it can be a struggle to list anything big, but even the smallest things deserve gratitude. Another high form of thanksgiving is going to Mass and receiving the Eucharist. The word Eucharist comes from the Greek word *eucharistia*, which means "thanksgiving."



THE FEAST of SAINT LUCY

Black Catholic History Month

Born in Santiago, Cuba, **Venerable Mother Mary Lange, OSP**, migrated to Baltimore in the early 1880s, at the same time as many French-speaking refugees from Haiti. She



founded the St. Frances Academy—the nation's first Catholic school for African-Americans which is still in operation today.

She founded the Oblate Sisters of Providence in 1829, the nation's first religious women's community for those of African ancestry.
