


The Feast of Saint Lucy




Black Catholic History Month

This vibrantly illustrated book introduces children to the life of St. Martin de Porres, a remarkable and courageous saint who is the patron of mixed-race people, barbers, innkeepers, public health workers, and those seeking and working for racial harmony.

Thea Bowman: Faithful And Free (middle school kids) With every passing year since her death in 1990, more people are recognizing Sister Thea Bowman as one of the most inspiring figures in American Catholic history.
