




DECEMBER | 7 | 2025

This Monday, December 8 is the Feast of the Immaculate Conception which celebrates the moment when Mary herself was conceived without sin, prepared by God from the very beginning to bear the Christ Child. Her immaculate beginning reveals God's desire to draw humanity back to holiness through His Son. In this spirit of grace and anticipation, our Advent Mission (December 15-17 at St. Mary) will explore how Jesus draws us into His Sacred Heart. Fr. Jones will help us discover how a deeper life of prayer opens the door to Jesus' heart, where He offers peace, love, and transforming grace (more details on page 6). As we journey through Advent, we follow Mary's example of openness and trust, allowing Christ to lead us ever closer to His Sacred Heart as we await His coming.







Future Godparent or Sponsor Role?



Many of us were not taught that as baptized Catholics we are required to be married in a Catholic Church or obtain permission from the Archbishop to be married in a non-Catholic ceremony. In order to participate fully in the sacramental life of the Church, including serving as a godparent or sponsor and receiving the Eucharist, our marriages must first be deemed valid by the Church. EPIC: Seniors with Christmas Spirit







Marriage Solutions

If you are having trouble within your marriage, especially if you are considering separation, the Church is here to help you. There is no such thing as Catholic divorce, as marriage is a permanent, unbreakable institution. Even if you think you and your spouse are beyond all reconciliation, there is hope and there is help. Even if you are separated or civilly divorced, your marriage bond is not broken. Please reach out to Deacon Nathan (deaconnathan@stceciliacincinnati.org) for a confidential meeting. Our clergy will either try to help you here, or guide you toward someone who can.

However, there are times when two people have attempted marriage invalidly, have separated, and are in need of the Church's help in order to marry in the future. Catholics who are in this state do not need to refrain from the Sacraments unless they have already attempted marriage again or are in a relationship with a person other than their spouse. If you suspect your prior marriage may be invalid, we can help with the annulment process. Please reach out to Joe Fondacaro at 513-871-5757, ext. 222. All inquiries are kept in the strictest confidence.






