

This Thursday, January 1, is a holy day of obligation. Let us begin our New Year celebrating the God-bearer. We honor her as she leads us closer to her Son. As we enter this new year, may she intercede for us and inspire us with renewed faith. Let us grow like our Mother Mary and choose to accept God's will for us, giving Him a resounding **yes** in everything He asks.

How to grow in your faith in the new year: Marian devotion—try a 33-day consecration to Mary (e.g., *33 Days to Morning Glory*). Create a prayer space—a home altar or prayer corner. Practice gratitude for God's blessings every day. Go to daily Mass, monthly Confessions, pray the Rosary every day. Schedule time to pray and go to Adoration.



Brotherhood of the Holy Rosary

Pray the rosary. Witness your faith. Men who have or wish to develop a devotion to the Blessed Virgin through the rosary are welcome to join the Brotherhood of the Holy Rosary on the first Saturday of every month at 7:30 AM to pray the rosary on the steps in front of the St. Cecilia church. 


Homebound Ministry

We are in need of additional helpers to take communion to those who cannot make it to church.


- 1) Currently we need someone for a parishioner that lives on Maple Avenue in Avondale.




Men's Ignatian Weekend Retreat

Closing of the Jubilee Year with Archbishop Casey



Gifts of Appreciated Securities – Donate appreciated stocks, bonds, or mutual funds to avoid capital gains tax and receive a deduction for the full market value. **Must be received by December 20, 2025.**

Tax-Wise Planning – Accelerating 2026 gifts into 2025 may help you itemize deductions. Standard deduction thresholds: **1) Joint: \$31,500 2) Head of Household: \$23,625 3) Single: \$15,750 4) Additional: \$2,000 per person age 65+**
