The main epiphanies, divine revelations, given to Daniel by the angels were passed down and studied by the wise men of the east. These wise men, the Magi—*magicians* or *mystics*—had studied the prophecies and waited for the coming of the Messiah. These prophecies were to unveil God’s divine plan, so when the birth of our Lord came to be in Bethlehem, the Magi traveled to seek out His birth by following the star. They recognized the Star of Bethlehem because Daniel preserved the Jewish prophecies.

Let us celebrate this beautiful feast day by recognizing the wise men and writing with blessed chalk above our doors, “20+C+M+B+26” the letters stand for Caspar, Melchior, Balthazar (the traditional names of the three wise men) and *Christus Mansionem Benedicat* (May Christ bless this house).




Homebound Ministry

We are in need of additional helpers to take communion to those who cannot make it to church.


- 1) Currently we need someone for a parishioner that lives on Maple Avenue in Avondale.






