Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent, a sacred season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that prepares our hearts for the celebration of Easter. As ashes are placed on our foreheads, we are reminded of our human weakness, "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return," and of our constant need for God's mercy and grace. In the Gospel from Matthew 6:1–6, 16–18, Jesus calls us to live these Lenten practices with humility and sincerity, not for outward display but as a genuine offering to God. He invites us to pray in secret, to fast with a joyful and sincere heart, and to give alms quietly, trusting that our Father who sees in secret will repay us. Ash Wednesday, therefore, sets the tone for a Lent rooted not in appearances, but in a deeper conversion of heart that draws us closer to Christ.


Meetings will be hosted on Mondays at 7 pm beginning on **February 23** in the St. Cecilia Commons.





### Fast and Abstinence Guidelines for Lent

- **Ages 18-59:** Fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting allows one full meal a day.
- **Ages 14 and up:** Abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays of Lent.

### Palm-Burning Service

To close out Ordinary Time, we will have a half-hour prayer service this Tuesday, **February 17**, at 6:30 p.m. This prayer service will include the solemn closing of the back altar doors, the addition of violet décor to the sanctuary and the singing of the last "Alleluia." The prayers will conclude with the burning of last year's palms for the ashes to be used on Ash Wednesday.



### Stations of the Cross during Lent


life prayer vigils and other pro-life activity at Holy Name.
