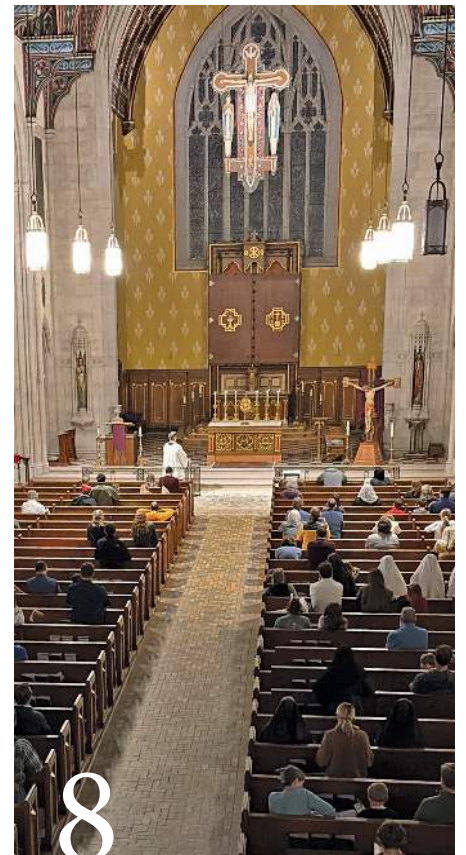
# *Solemnity of St. Joseph*

## Divine Mercy Reflection

Here within our parish family at St. Cecilia, we are blessed with a large and beautiful image of Jesus the Divine Mercy. Jesus Himself specifically requested that this image be painted, and there is much to contemplate within it: His gentle yet searching eyes that look upon each soul with love, His raised hand offering blessing, His Heart overflowing with mercy and grace, and His posture of stepping out toward us. This image reminds us that Jesus is not a distant Savior, but One who comes close, who makes the first move, and who seeks us exactly where we are.

In paragraph 1485 of St. Faustina's Diary, Jesus speaks words meant for each of us: *"Be not afraid of your Savior; O sinful soul. I make the first move to come to you... be willing to talk openly with your God of mercy who wants to speak words of pardon and lavish His graces on you... How dear your soul is to Me!"* These words reveal a love that is intimate, personal, and unending.

This Lent, we are invited to encounter this Love more deeply through Eucharistic Adoration, especially on Tuesday evenings at St. Mary's and Wednesdays at St. Cecilia. As we kneel before Jesus, we place ourselves in the "rays of mercy" depicted in the Divine Mercy image. My own conversion began when a priest challenged me to spend one hour a day before Jesus for one week. I was changed—not by effort or specific prayers, but by His presence. Just as standing in sunlight leaves its mark on our skin, remaining in the radiance of Christ's mercy transforms our souls. This Lent, come, gaze upon Him, ponder the Image, and pray with faith, "Jesus, I trust in You."

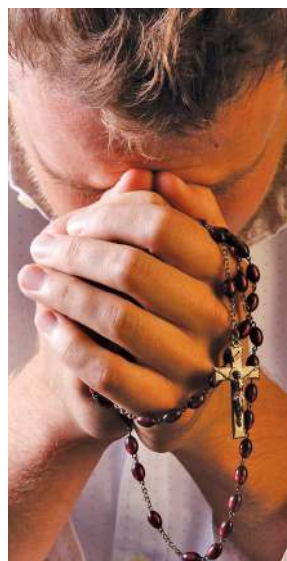


### Fast and Abstinence Guidelines for Lent

- **Ages 18-59:** Fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting allows one full meal a day.
- **Ages 14 and up:** Abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays of Lent.

### Stations of the Cross during Lent

Every Friday during Lent, we will pray the Stations of the Cross at 9:30 AM and 7 PM at Saint Cecilia Church, and at 5:30 PM at St. Mary. Through meditation and prayer, we will walk with our Savior on his way of suffering from the time he was condemned to death until he died and was buried. Make this devotion part of your Lenten commitment to prayer and grow closer to Christ.

#### **Week 3: Rights and Responsibilities**

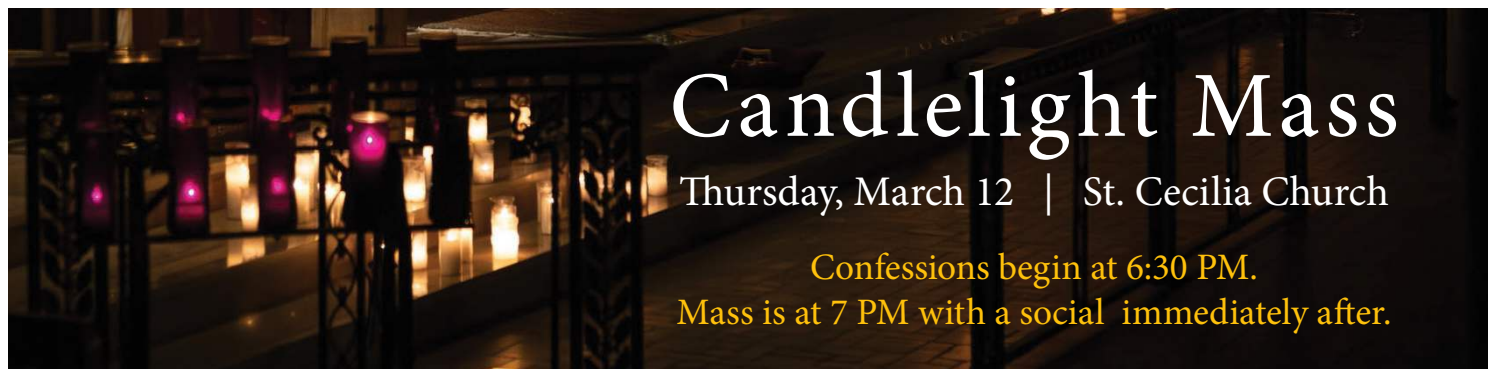
Every right we have comes with a responsibility to use it for the good of others, not just ourselves. When we balance our rights with care for one another, everyone flourishes.

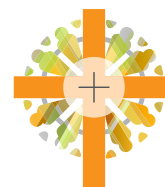
