St. Bernard of Clairvaux has a beautiful interpretation in one of his Palm Sunday reflections where he compares the joyful triumph of Jesus parading into Jerusalem with green palms being laid at his feet, leading to the procession of the Passion. Instead of green palms, in the Passion, He is crowned with thorns. Where they rejoiced in saying, “Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!,” they then turned and exclaimed, “Crucify Him!” This still reflects how we, at times, turn away from our loyalty to God, wavering in our faith and devotion. On Palm Sunday, although the people rejoiced in His presence, Jesus stayed humble and steadfast.

Let us not rejoice today and then abandon Him. Let us humble ourselves and repent. Lent is a time of repentance, and we offer many opportunities for you to go to confession. If you haven’t been in a while, please come and feel the weight of your sins be lifted. Our Lord has given us this incredible gift, and we should mirror His humility, no matter how difficult it may be. Please check the Eastside Catholics website for times.

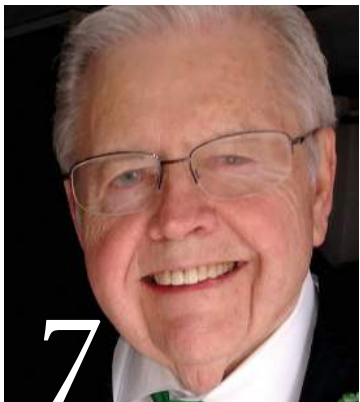

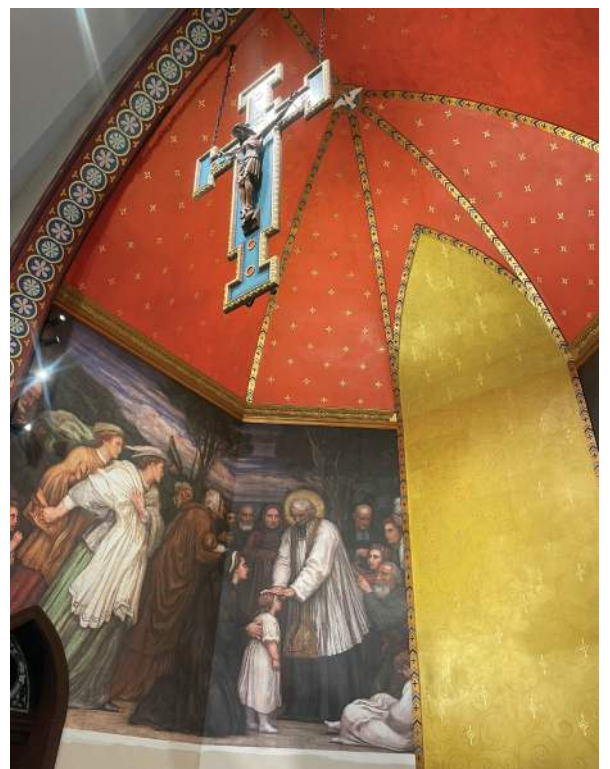
Eastertide Mass at the Seminary

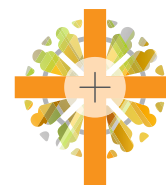
