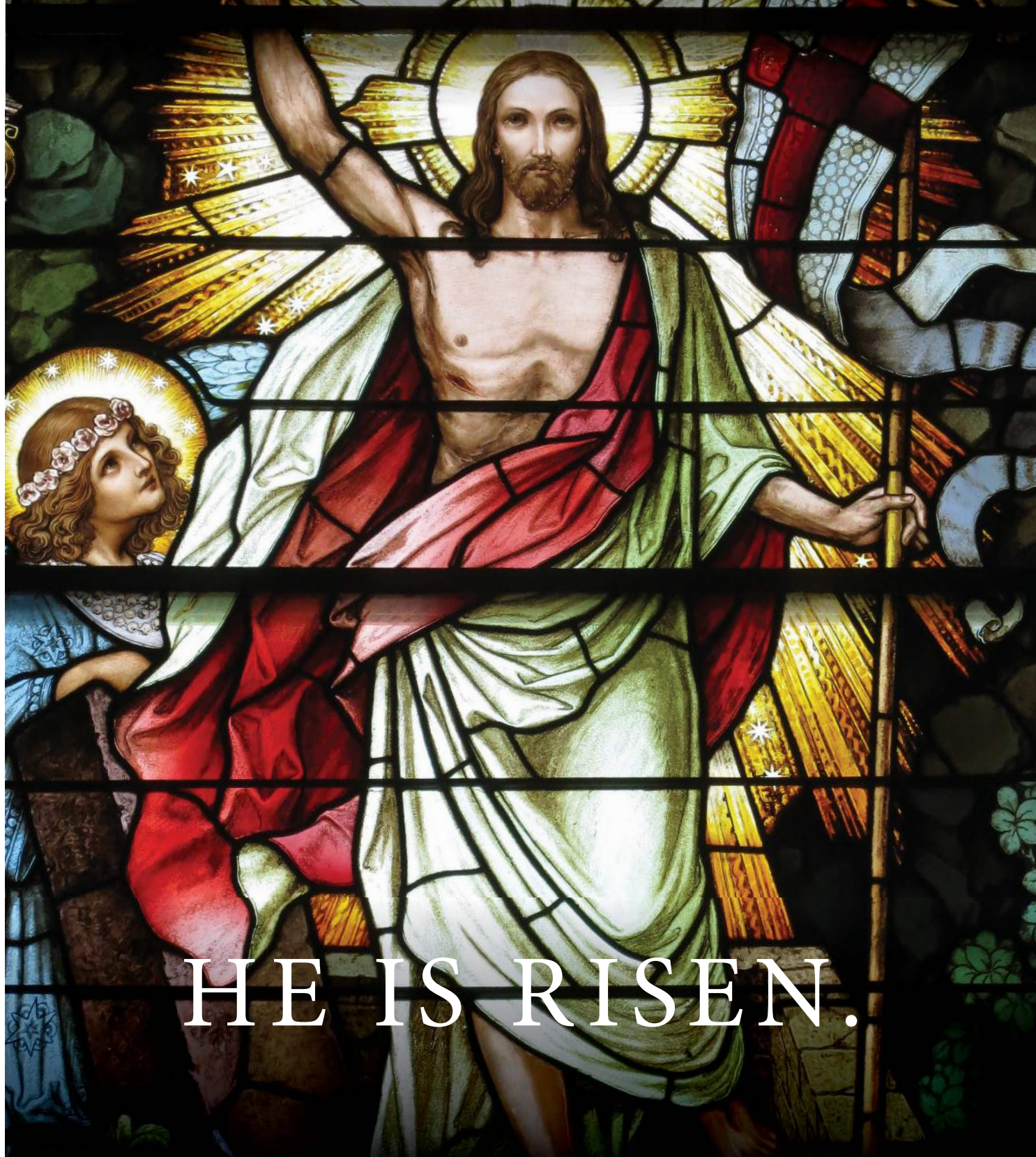

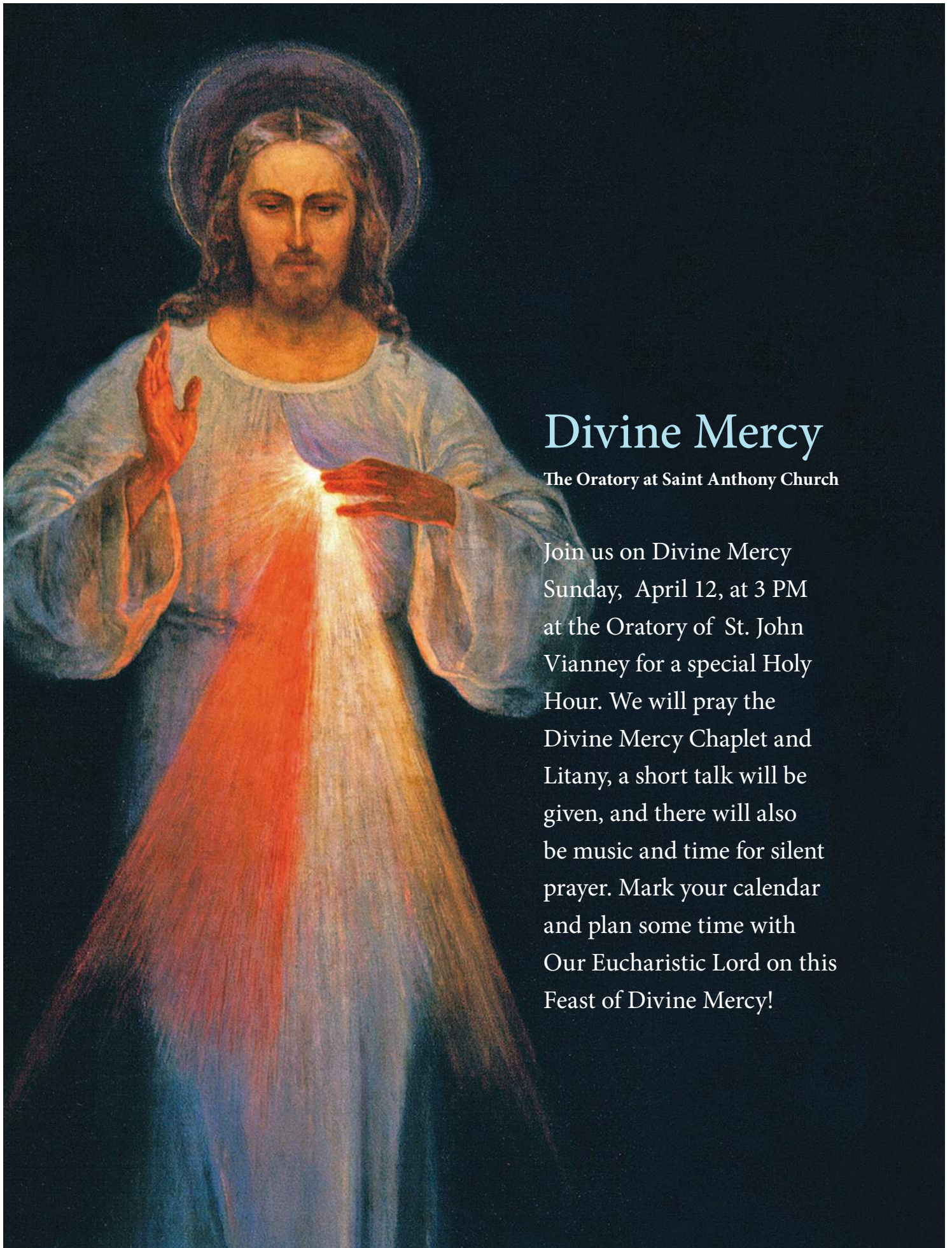

40s Plus Fun Bunch

On **April 12**, you are invited to celebrate Easter with an Eastertide Choral Mass at the Athenaeum of Ohio in the historic Chapel of St. Gregory the Great. An organ recital begins at 6:30 PM, followed by Mass and a sacred choral performance at 7 PM. Admission is free, with plenty of parking. BEGINNING ON DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY, we will begin to sing the Ordinaries of the Mass (the *Kyrie, Gloria, Sanctus, and Agnus Dei*) in Greek and Latin at the **St. Cecilia 8 AM and 10 AM Masses**. This is something we plan to continue, and I wanted to share a bit about why.

Latin has been the language of the Roman Rite for centuries, and it still holds a special place in the life of the Church. When we pray these ancient texts, we're joining not only Catholics around the world today, but also generations before us who worshipped with the very same words. There's something powerful about that continuity—it reminds us that the Mass is bigger than any one parish or moment in time.



At the same time, Latin has a unique beauty that really lends itself to prayer. Its rhythm, clarity, and solemnity help set these sacred texts apart from everyday speech, creating a sense of reverence and mystery. Even for those who don't speak the language, the music and structure of Latin can draw us into a deeper, more contemplative way of participating in the Mass.

The Church has also consistently encouraged this practice. The Second Vatican Council taught that Latin should be preserved in the liturgy and expressed the hope that the faithful would be able to pray and sing parts of the Mass in Latin together. In 1974, after the Second Vatican Council, Pope Paul VI released the *Jubilate Deo*, a collection of Latin chants seen as a "minimum repertoire," further promoting the use of Latin texts in

key parts of the Mass as a bridge to the tradition of the church amid the reforms of that council.

I invite of you to join in singing and praying these parts of the Mass with us, allowing their beauty and depth to draw us closer together as one worshipping community.
