



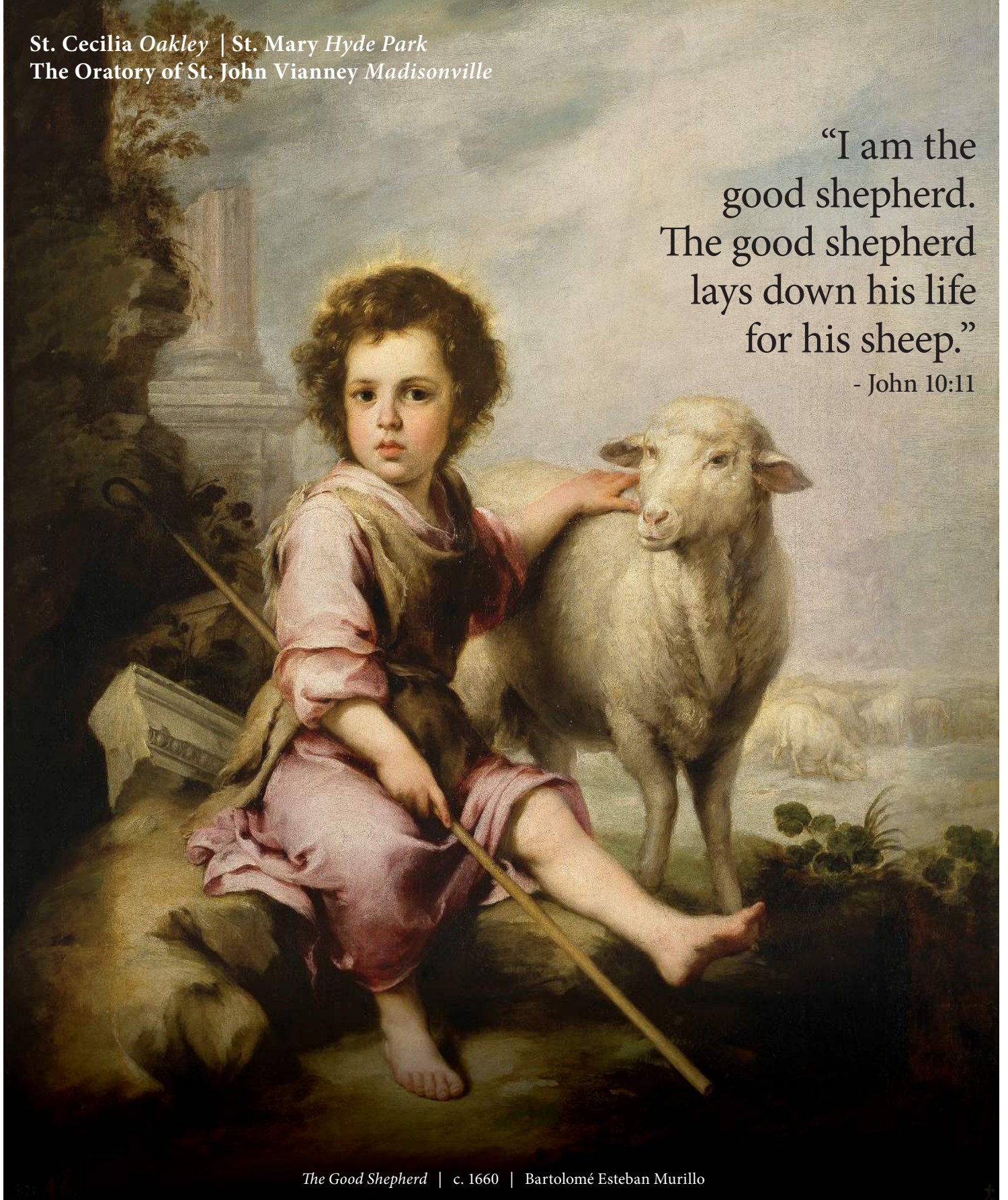

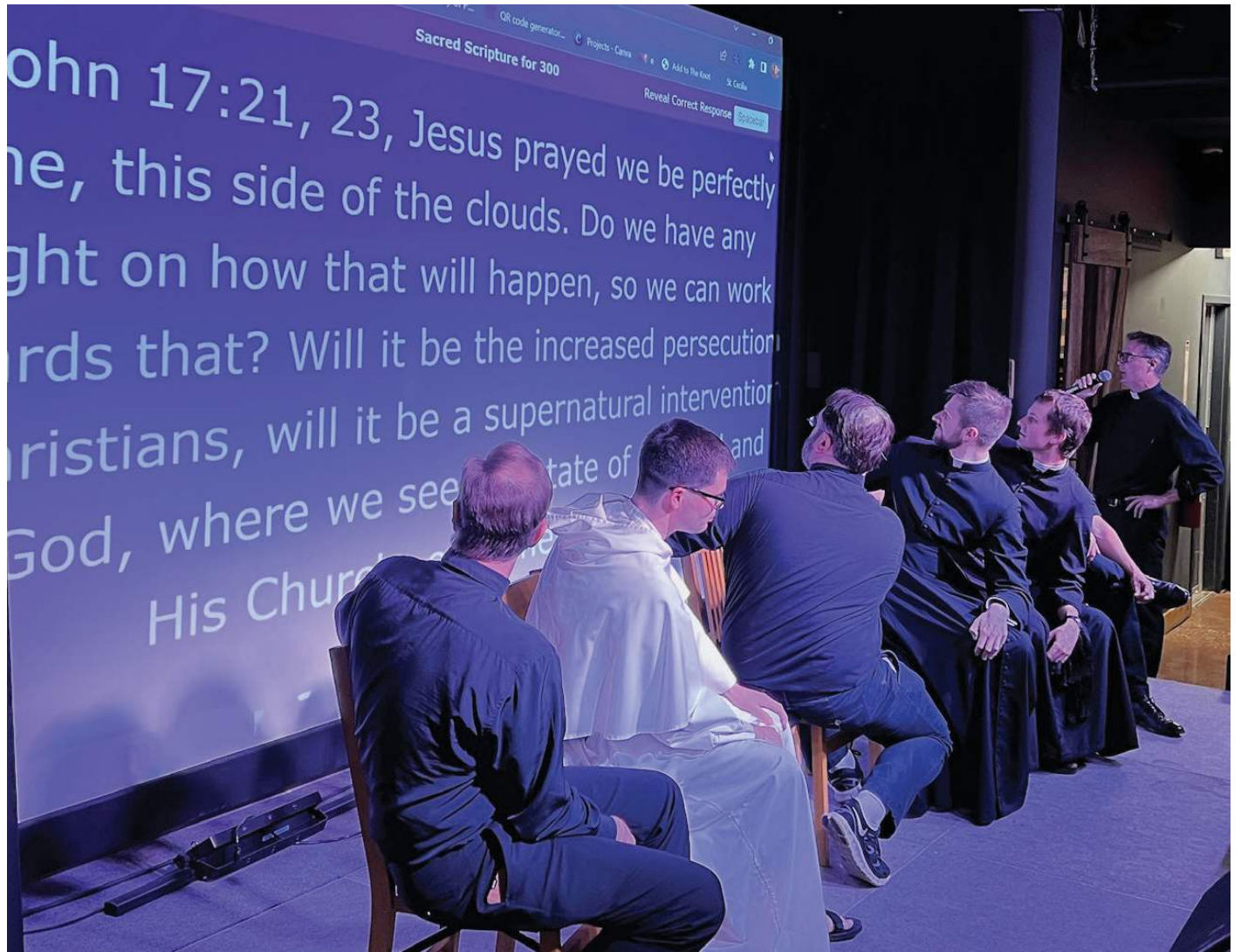

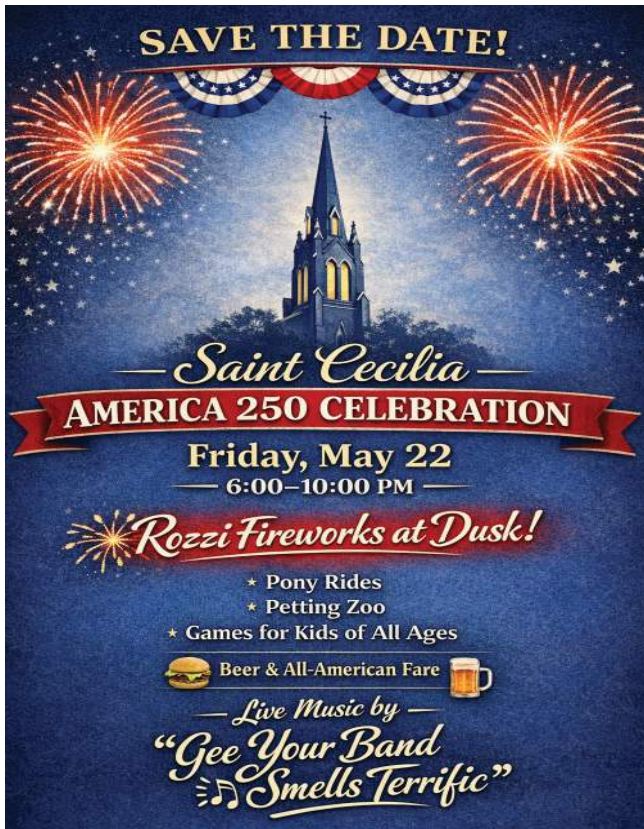

**He Knows You**

Since Easter, many have returned. Some after time away. Some still unsure. Some simply taking the next step. And maybe you're still wondering where you fit. This weekend, we hear Jesus speak as the Good Shepherd. Not to a crowd. But to each person. "I know my sheep... and mine know me." (John 10:14) This is not a distant or general kind of knowing. It is personal. He knows your story. Your questions. Your hopes—and even the parts you're still figuring out. And He does not stand far off. He leads. He calls. He walks with us. "The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want." (Psalm 23) In a world that often feels uncertain or overwhelming, this is the promise: You are not alone.

The Church—our parish family—is meant to be a place where that care becomes real. A place to be known. A place to be led. A place to find rest. If you've been coming back these past few weeks—don't disappear now. The Good Shepherd is calling you to stay. Stay. Keep coming. Let yourself be known—not just by God, but within this community. And when you are ready, consider helping ensure that every person who walks through these doors has the same chance to be known, welcomed, and cared for.
