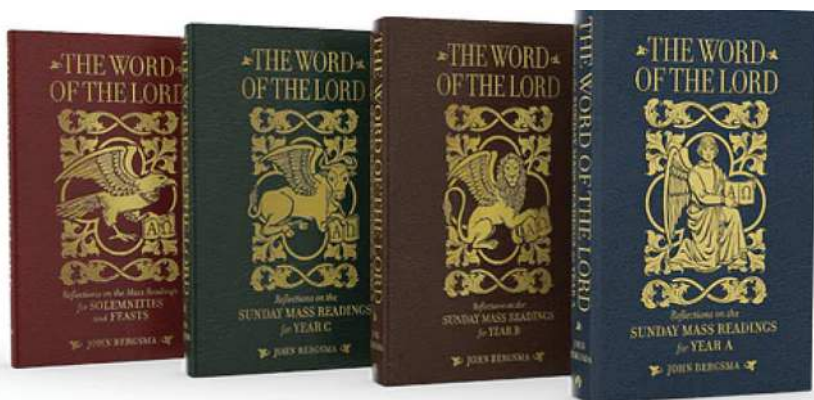


### Holy Hour at the Oratory to Pray for Priests

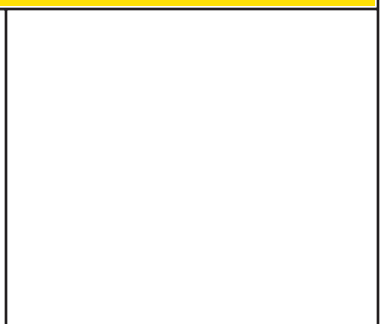
