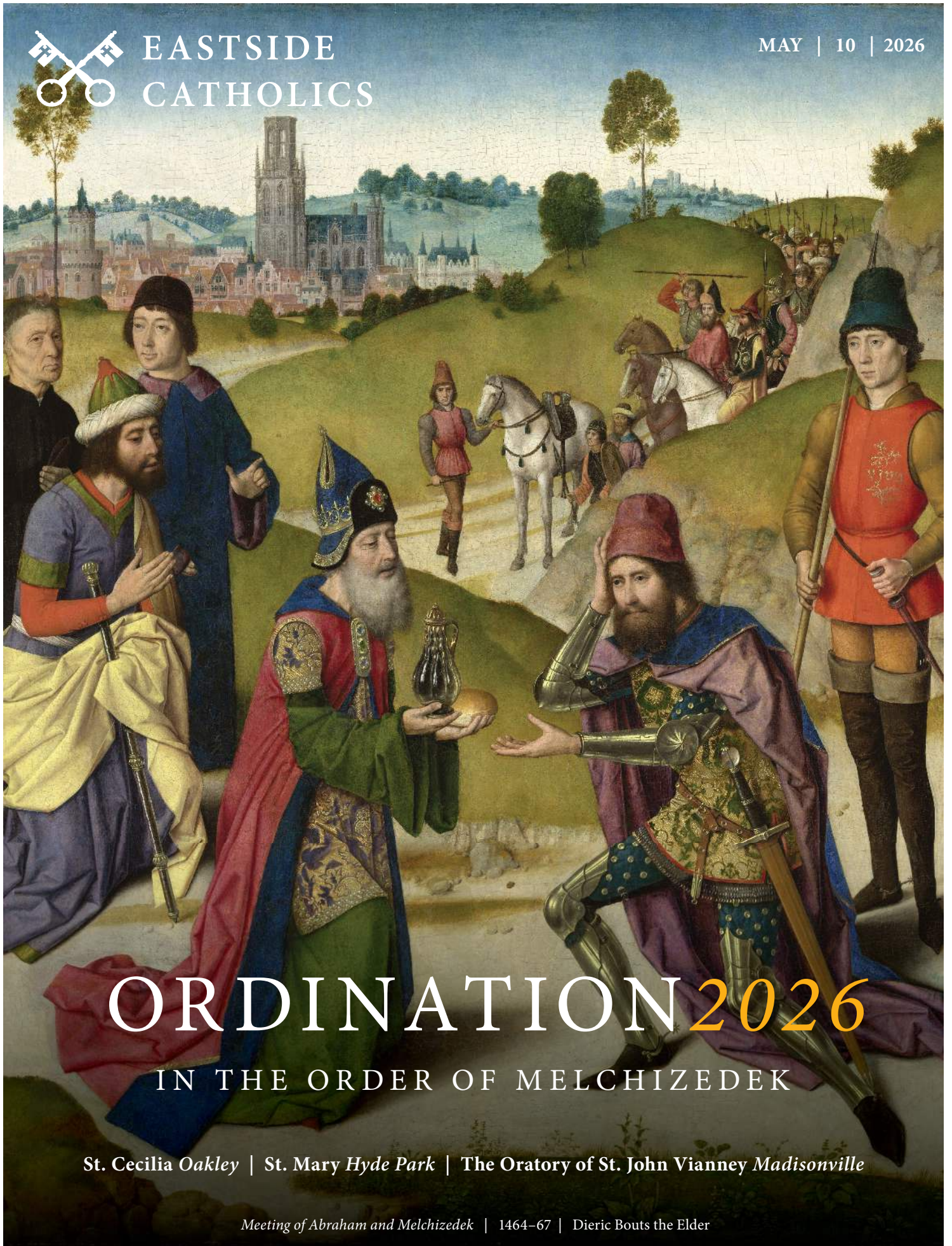

# PASTOR'S RAMBLINGS | 5

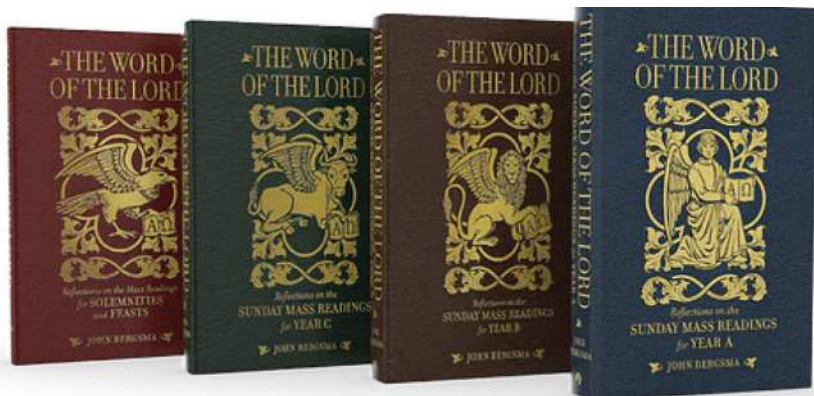
