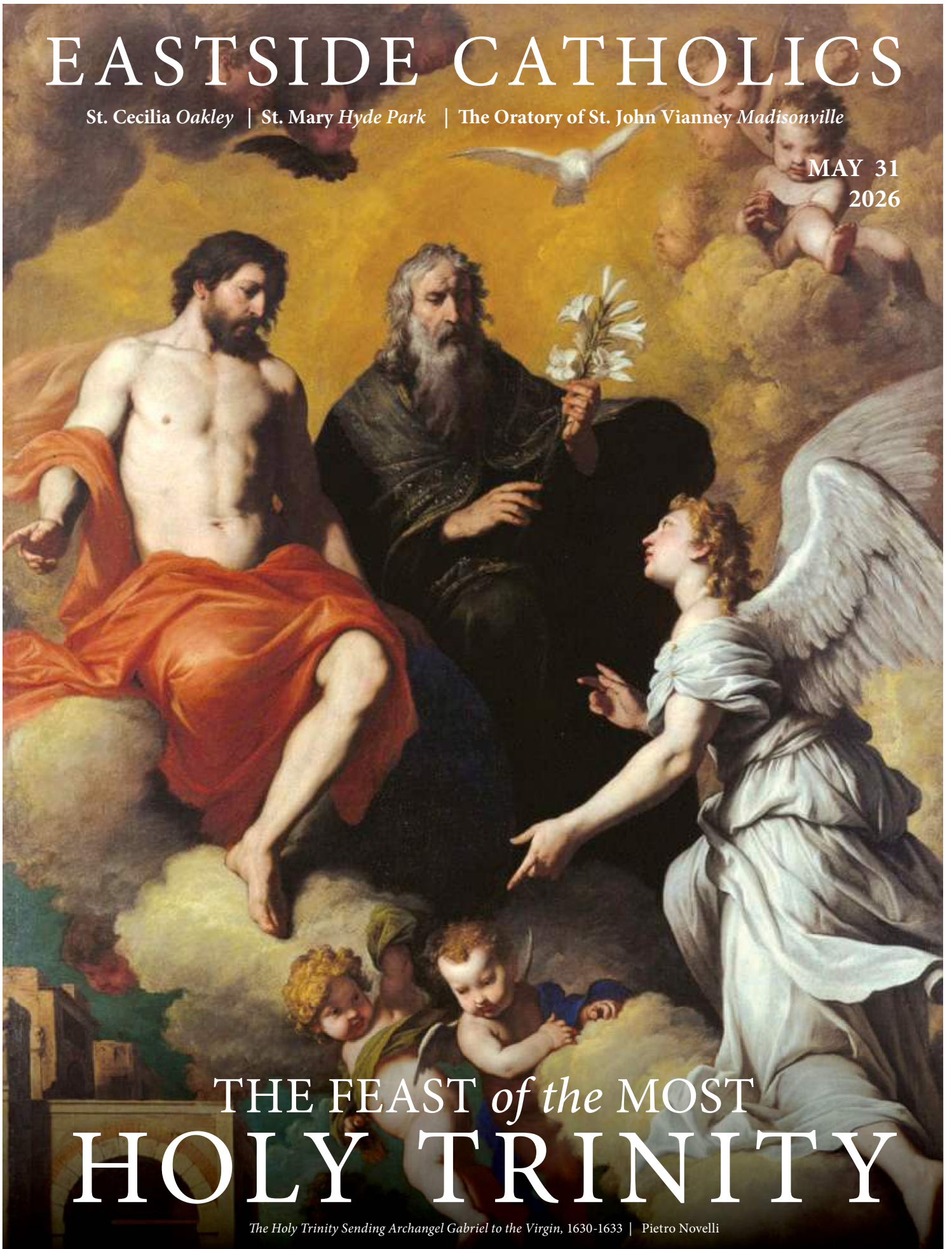

Brotherhood of the Holy Rosary

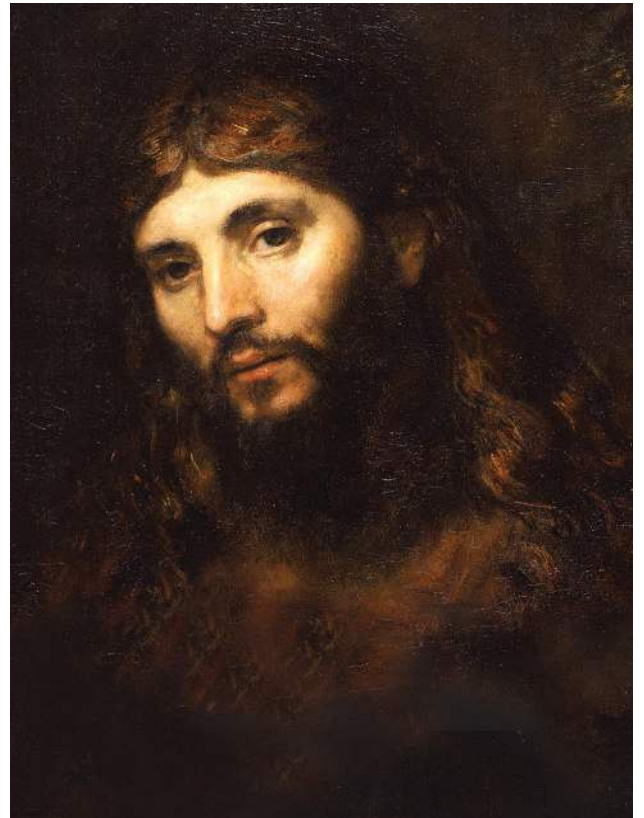

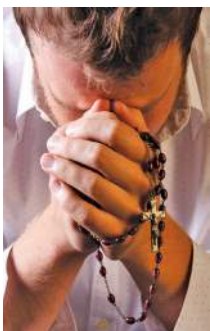

Made for Communion

As we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity**, we are reminded that at the very heart of our faith is not simply an idea or a rule—but a relationship. Father, Son, and Holy Spirit exist in perfect communion. A God of love, unity, mercy, and self-gift.

In the Gospel, we hear one of the most familiar and beautiful passages in Scripture: "**God so loved the world that he gave his only Son...**" (John 3:16). Everything begins with God's generosity. Before we ever give anything back to Him, He first gives Himself to us.

Christian stewardship flows from this truth. Stewardship is not primarily about fundraising or programs. It is about learning to live like the Trinity: receiving God's love, sharing that love with others, and recognizing that we belong to one another as members of the Body of Christ.

St. Paul writes, "**Live in peace, and the God of love and peace will be with you.**" Stewardship invites us into that same fellowship. Every prayer offered, every volunteer hour, every act of hospitality, every gift shared, and every invitation extended helps build a parish family rooted not simply in activity, but in communion.

The Trinity also reminds us that faith is never lived alone. God Himself exists in relationship, and He calls us into relationship—with Him and with one another. In a world often marked by division, isolation, and busyness, the Church becomes a place where people can be known, loved, and accompanied.

As our parish family continues growing together, may we strive to reflect the life of the Trinity in the way we worship, serve, lead, and care for one another. And may everything we do point back to the God who is, always and forever, **rich in kindness and fidelity.**
