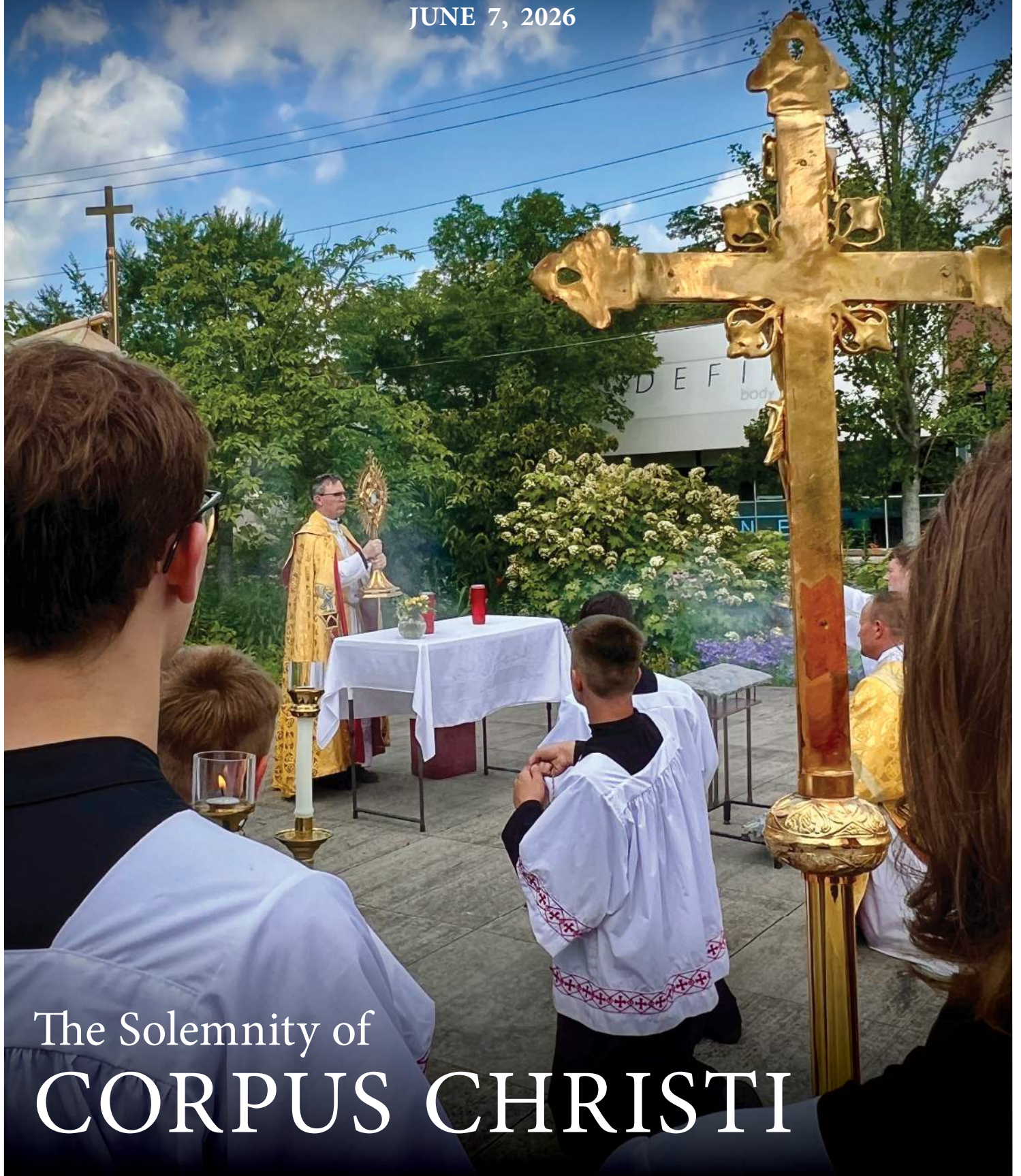

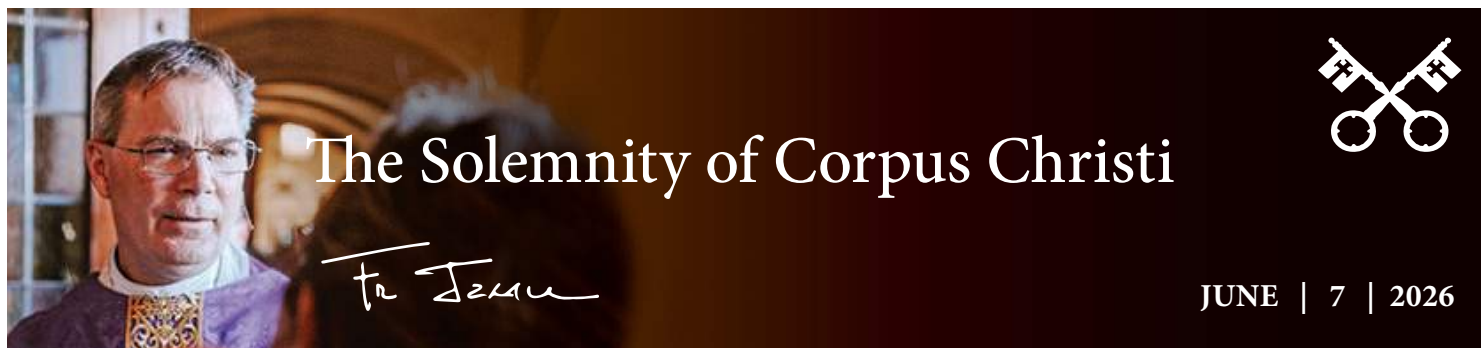

The Solemnity of Corpus Christi celebrates the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, His Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity truly present among us. Corpus Christi processions are a public witness of faith, as the Blessed Sacrament is carried through the church and streets in a monstrance, reminding us that Christ walks with His people each day. Through prayer and adoration, the faithful proclaim the Eucharist as the “source and summit” of our faith and bring the presence of Christ beyond the walls of the church into the world. Corpus Christi is a joyful celebration of this gift, the Lord who remains with His people always in the Eucharist.

I am so grateful that each church is having a procession to share the significance of witnessing our faith. Please process with profound reverence. When the monstrance passes by you, please make the Sign of the Cross and bow deeply or genuflect. Amen? Amen.

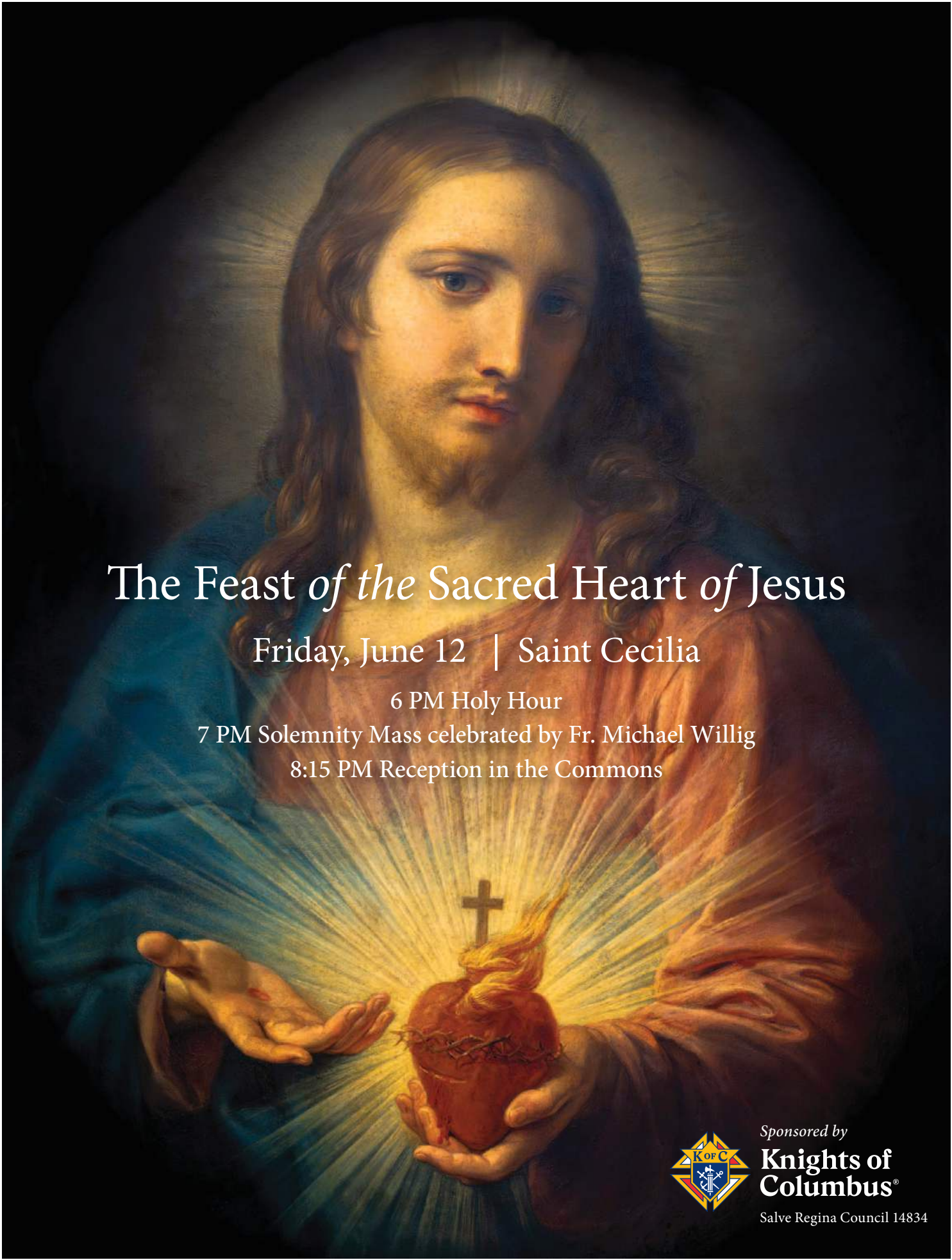

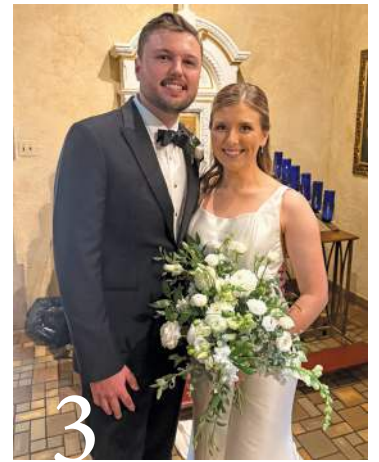

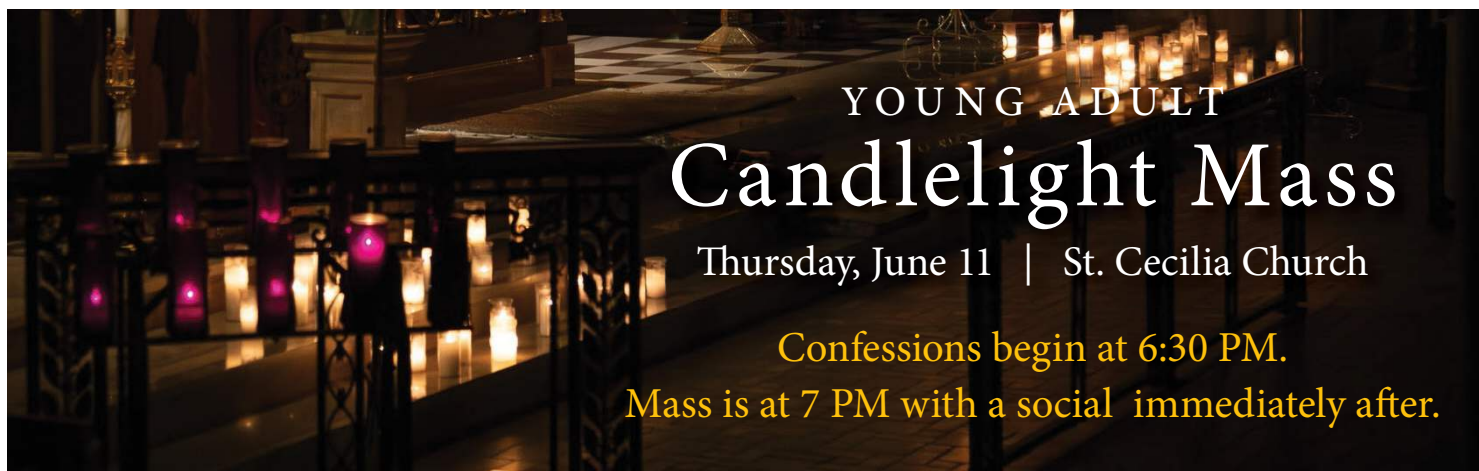

Catholics who are in this state do not need to refrain from the Sacraments unless they have already attempted marriage again or are in a relationship with a person other than their spouse. If you suspect your prior marriage may be invalid, we can help with the annulment process. He Remains With Us

On this Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, the Church reminds us of a profound truth: **Jesus does not remain distant from us. He remains with us in the Eucharist.**

In the desert, God fed His people with manna from heaven. But that gift pointed toward something even greater. In the Gospel, Jesus declares: **"I am the living bread that came down from heaven... whoever eats this bread will live forever." (John 6:51)**

The Eucharist is not simply a symbol. It is **communion with the living Christ Himself.**

St. Paul reminds us that "though many, we are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf." Around one altar, Christ gathers us together and forms us into one parish family. (1 Corinthians 10:17)

This is the heart of stewardship. Stewardship begins not with programs or budgets, but with **relationship, gratitude, and communion with Christ.** The Eucharist strengthens us to live generously, serve faithfully, and walk together in.

As we continue growing together as a parish family, may this feast renew in us a deeper love for the Mass, greater gratitude for one another, and a renewed desire to become what we receive: **the Body of Christ for the life of the world.**
