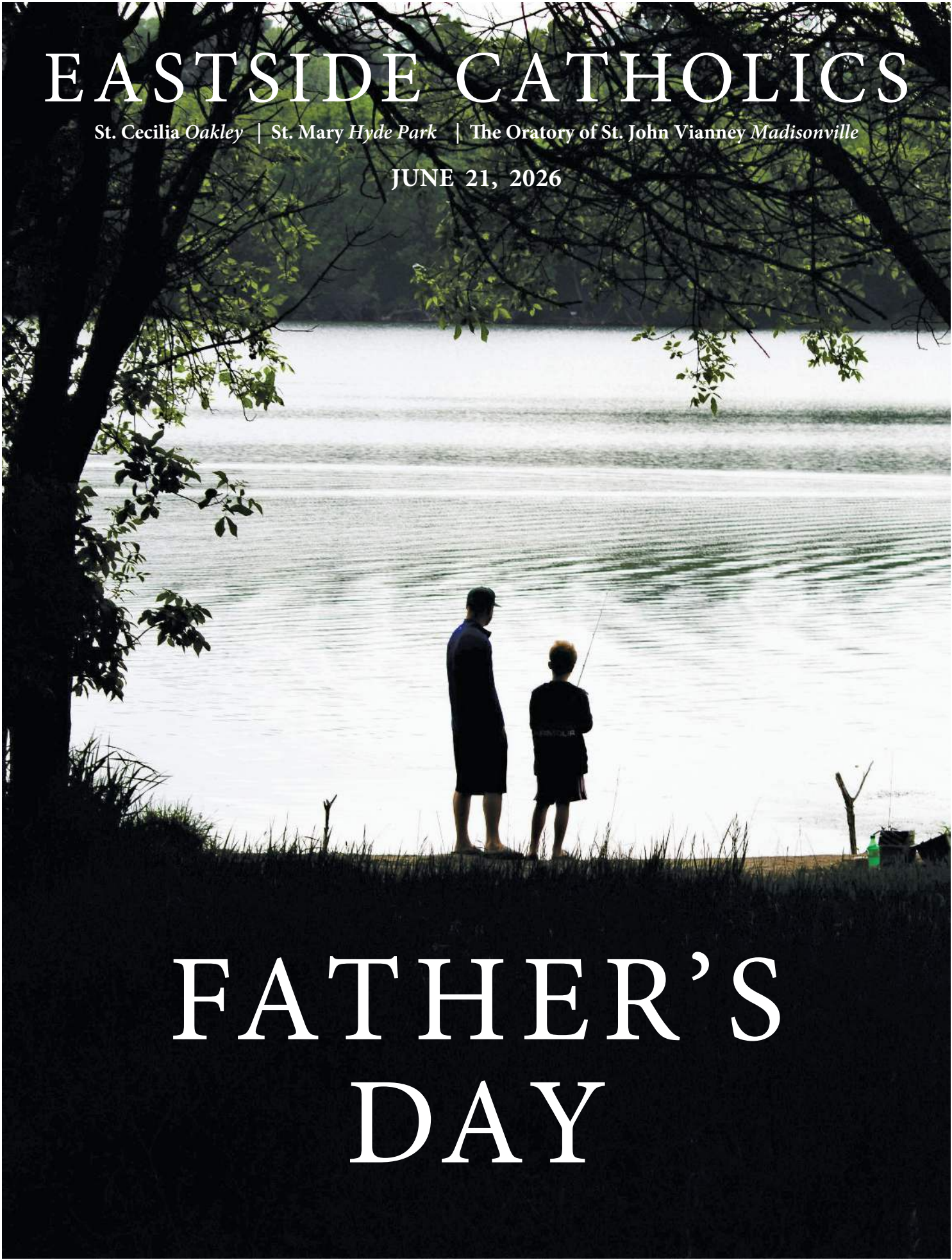

Family of Faith 2026-2027

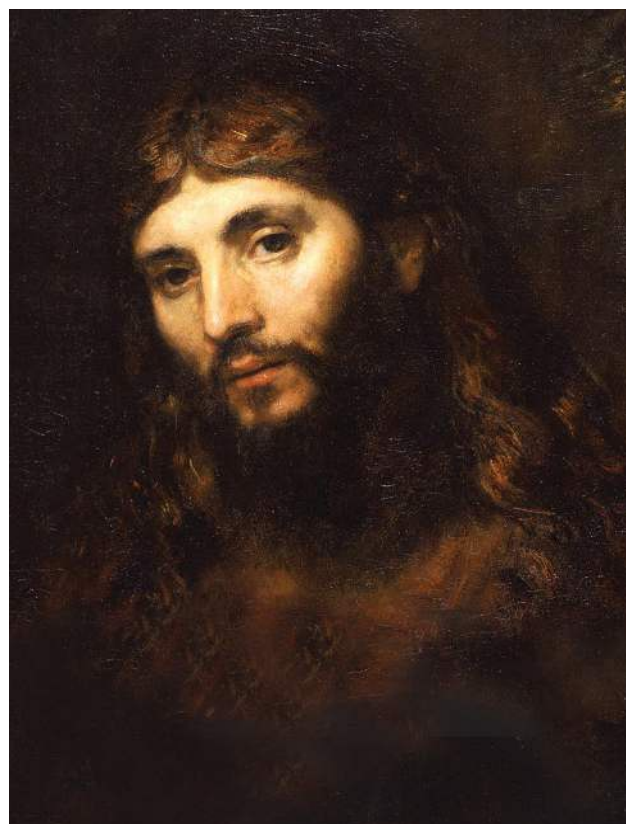

Registrations are now live for the 2026-2027 school year.

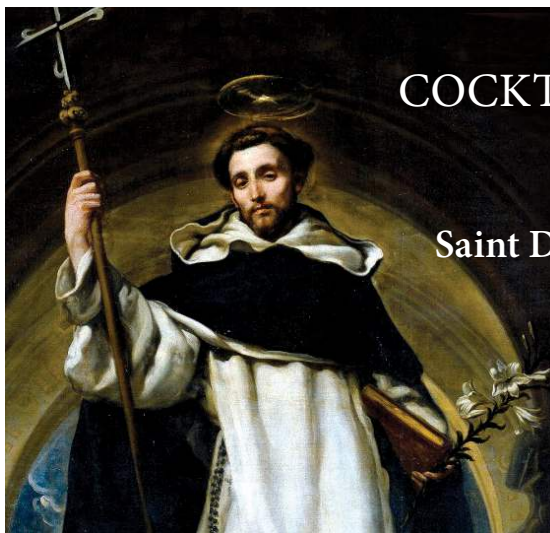

No Fear. Only Faith.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus offers a simple but powerful message: "Do not be afraid."

Those words are easier said than lived. We all face fears—about our families, finances, health, work, and the future. Yet throughout this weekend's readings, we see a common theme: God remains faithful, even when circumstances are difficult.

Jeremiah is rejected and persecuted, yet he trusts that the Lord stands beside him "like a mighty champion." The psalmist cries out for help, confident that God hears the poor and suffering. St. Paul reminds us that while sin entered the world through Adam, God's grace comes to us abundantly through Jesus Christ.

Christian stewardship begins with trust. Before we can generously offer our time, talent, and treasure, we must first believe that God is present, God is faithful, and God will provide.

Jesus reminds us that not even a sparrow falls without the Father's knowledge. If God cares for the sparrows, how much more does He care for each one of us?

Fear tells us to hold back. Faith invites us to surrender. As disciples, we are called to place our trust in the Lord, acknowledge Him boldly, and respond generously to the blessings He has entrusted to our care.

When we live with faith instead of fear, stewardship becomes a joyful response to God's great love. As we seek to live with faith instead of fear, may we respond generously to the blessings God has entrusted to our care. Thank you for supporting the mission of Eastside Catholics.
