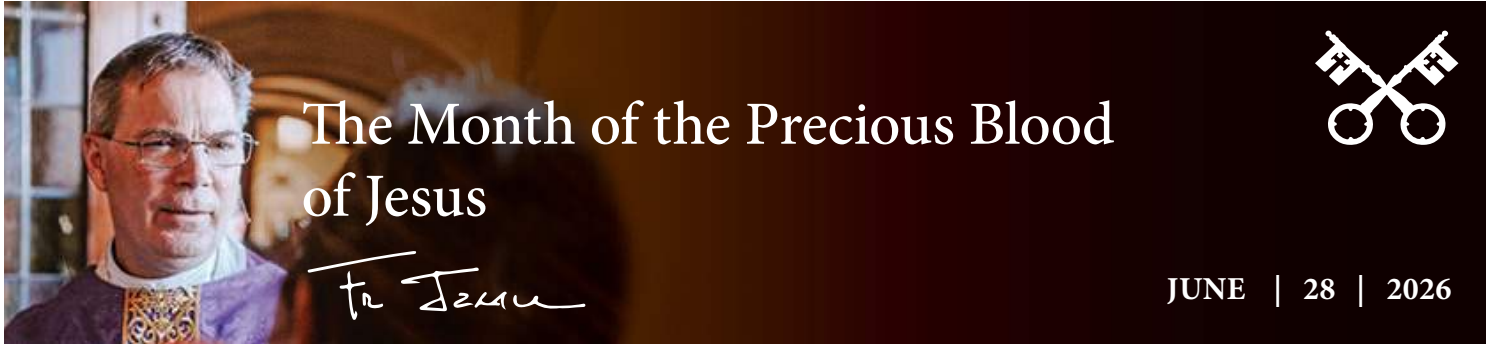

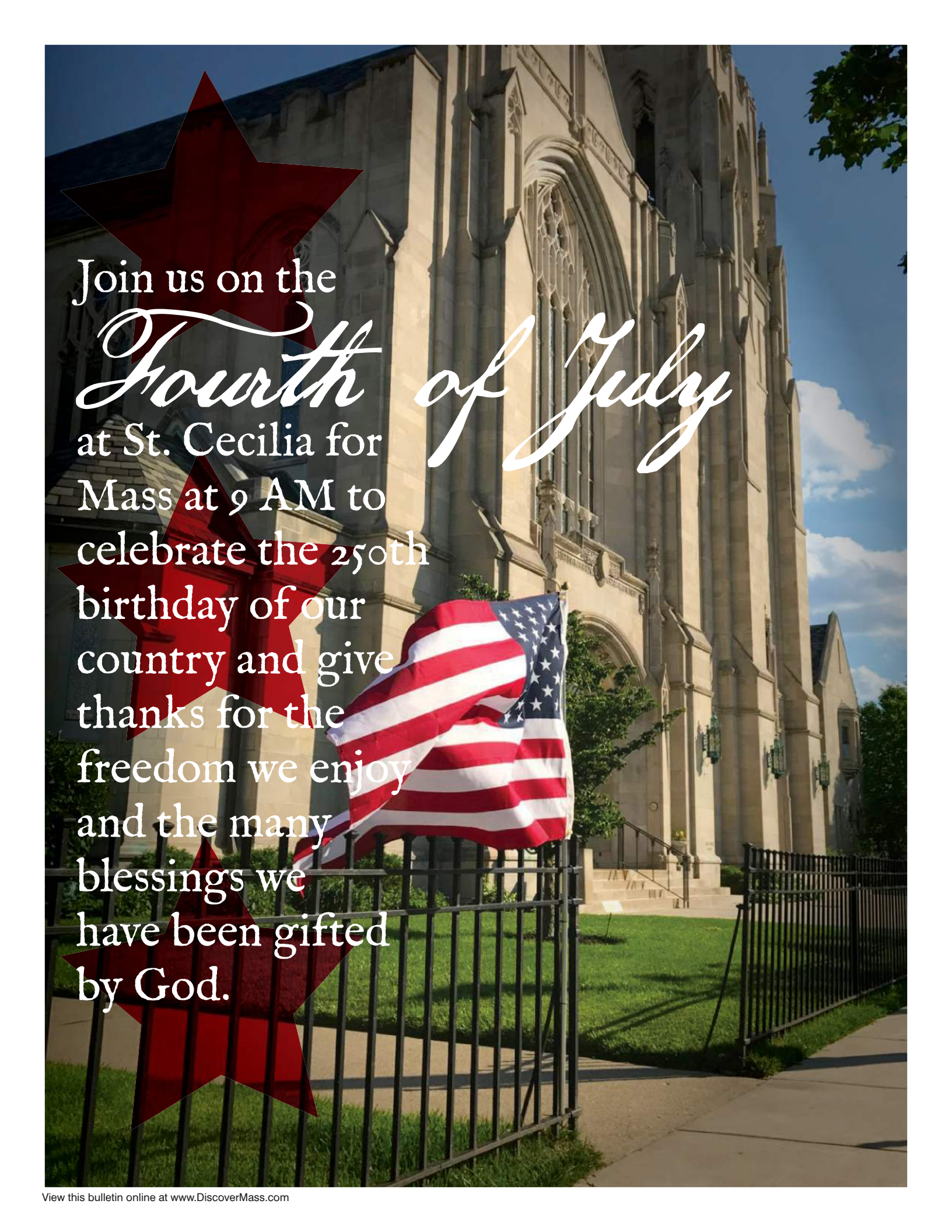
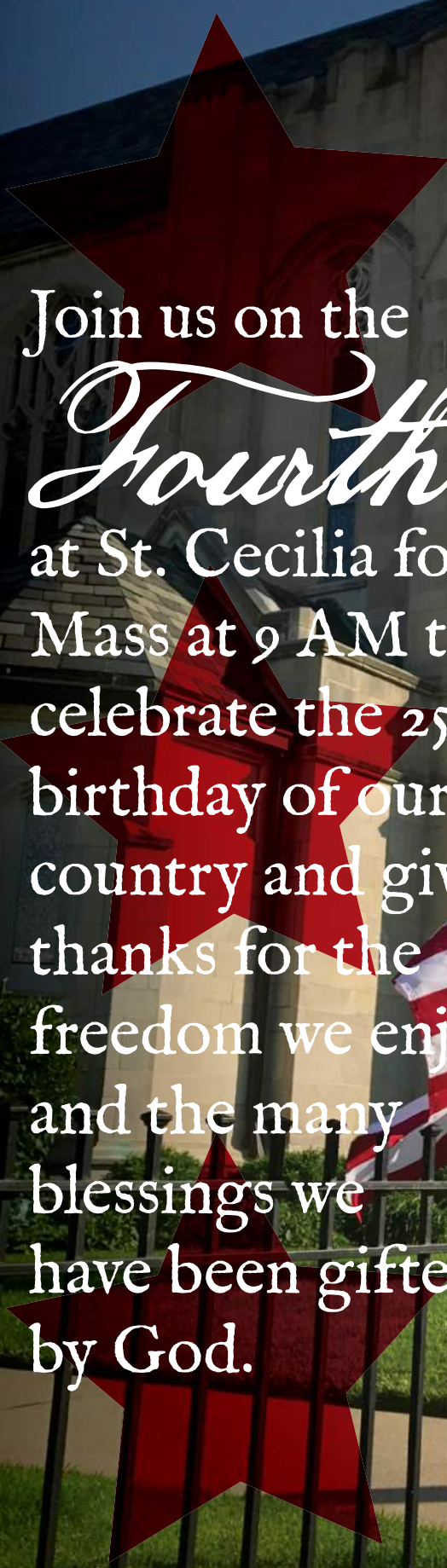

Family of Faith 2026-2027

Family of Faith is Eastside Catholics' official religious education program for children aged Pre-K through eighth grade. It equips parents to embrace their role as the primary catechists through monthly classes. The rest of the instruction occurs in the home.

Registrations are now live for the 2026-2027 school year.

Scan the QR code to register. Any family who wishes their children to receive either the sacrament of First Reconciliation, First Communion, and/or Confirmation needs to register for Family of Faith or be enrolled in either the parish schools or an approved Catholic homeschool co-op. For those not enrolled in these alternative options, all classroom preparation for these sacraments takes place within the monthly Family of Faith sessions.

Jesus teaches the same lesson in the Gospel: **whoever welcomes another in His name welcomes Christ Himself.** Even offering "a cup of cold water" to someone in need has eternal significance.

As Christian stewards, we are called to recognize that everything we have is a gift from God. Stewardship is simply asking, **"How can I use these gifts to serve others and glorify God?"**

Whether through prayer, service, encouragement, hospitality, or financial support, our faithful response allows Christ's love to be experienced by others. This week, consider: **Who is God inviting me to welcome? How can I share His love through a simple act of generosity?**
