Registrations are now live for the 2026-2027 school year.

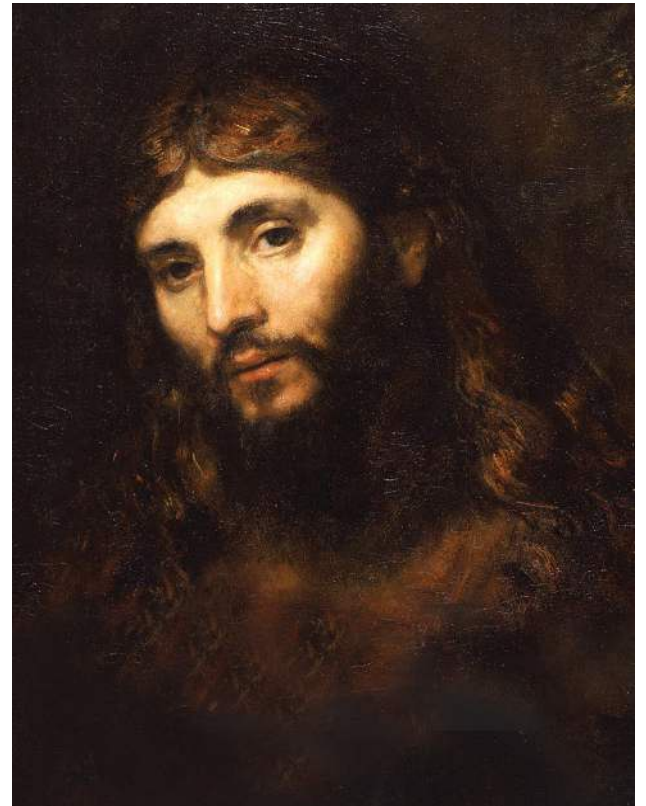

For those not enrolled in these alternative options, all classroom preparation for these sacraments takes place within the monthly Family of Faith sessions.

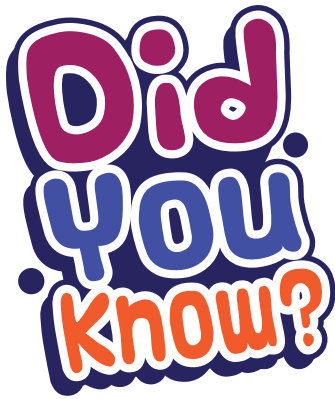

Come to Me and Find Rest
