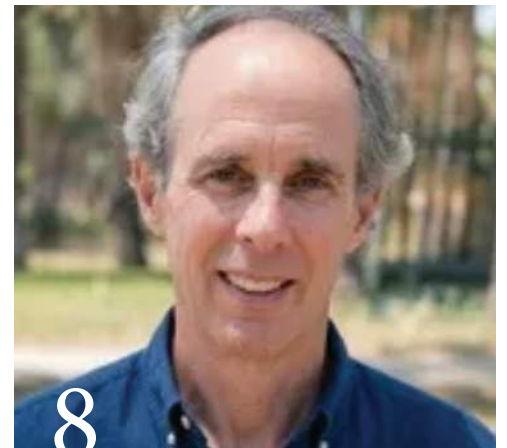
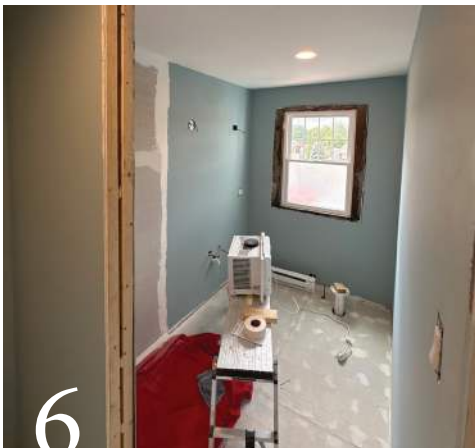

Family of Faith equips parents to embrace their role as the primary catechists through monthly classes. The rest of the instruction occurs in the home. **Registrations are now live for the 2026-2027 school year. 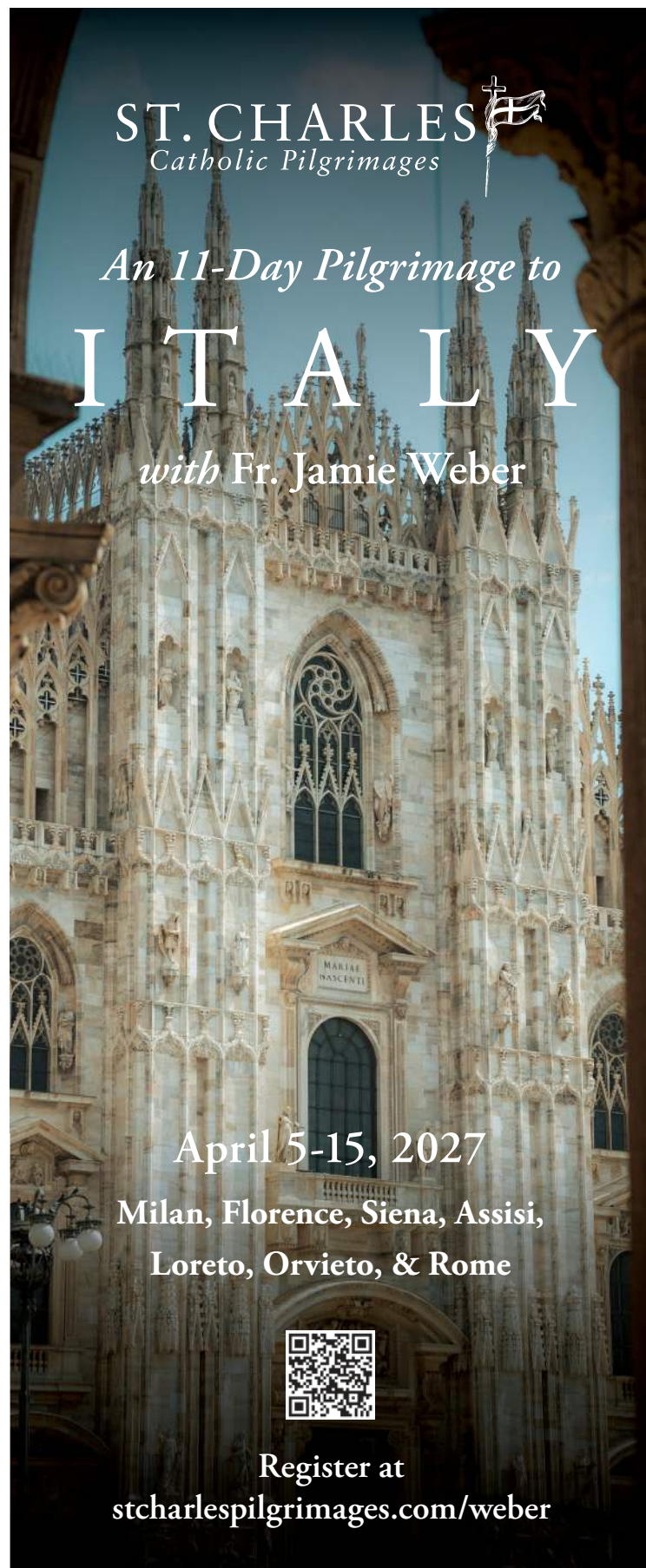

The Greatest Treasure

If God asked you the same question He asked Solomon—"Ask something of me and I will give it to you."—what would you ask for?

Solomon could have asked for wealth, power, or success. Instead, he asked for wisdom: an understanding heart that would help him serve God's people well. His request pleased the Lord because it revealed what Solomon treasured most—not personal gain, but God's will.

Jesus carries that same lesson into this Sunday's Gospel. He tells of a man who discovers a hidden treasure and a merchant who finds a pearl of great price. Both joyfully give up everything else because they have found something infinitely more valuable.

Stewardship begins with the same question: What do I treasure most?

When Christ is our greatest treasure, everything else begins to find its proper place. Our time is no longer something to protect at all costs but something to offer in love. Our talents become gifts to be shared rather than abilities to keep for ourselves. Our financial resources become tools for building God's Kingdom rather than simply accumulating more.

The remarkable detail in Jesus' parables is that both people acted out of joy. They weren't making reluctant sacrifices. They had discovered something so valuable that everything else seemed small by comparison.

That is the invitation for each of us. Stewardship isn't about giving things up because we have to. It's about recognizing what God has already given us in Christ and responding with grateful, generous hearts. The more we discover the treasure of a life rooted in Him, the more naturally generosity becomes a way of life.

This week, take a moment to ask yourself: What does the way I spend my time, use my gifts, and share my resources reveal about what I treasure most?

May we, like Solomon, seek hearts that are wise. And may we, like the merchant who found the pearl of great price, recognize that nothing compares to the joy of following Christ.
