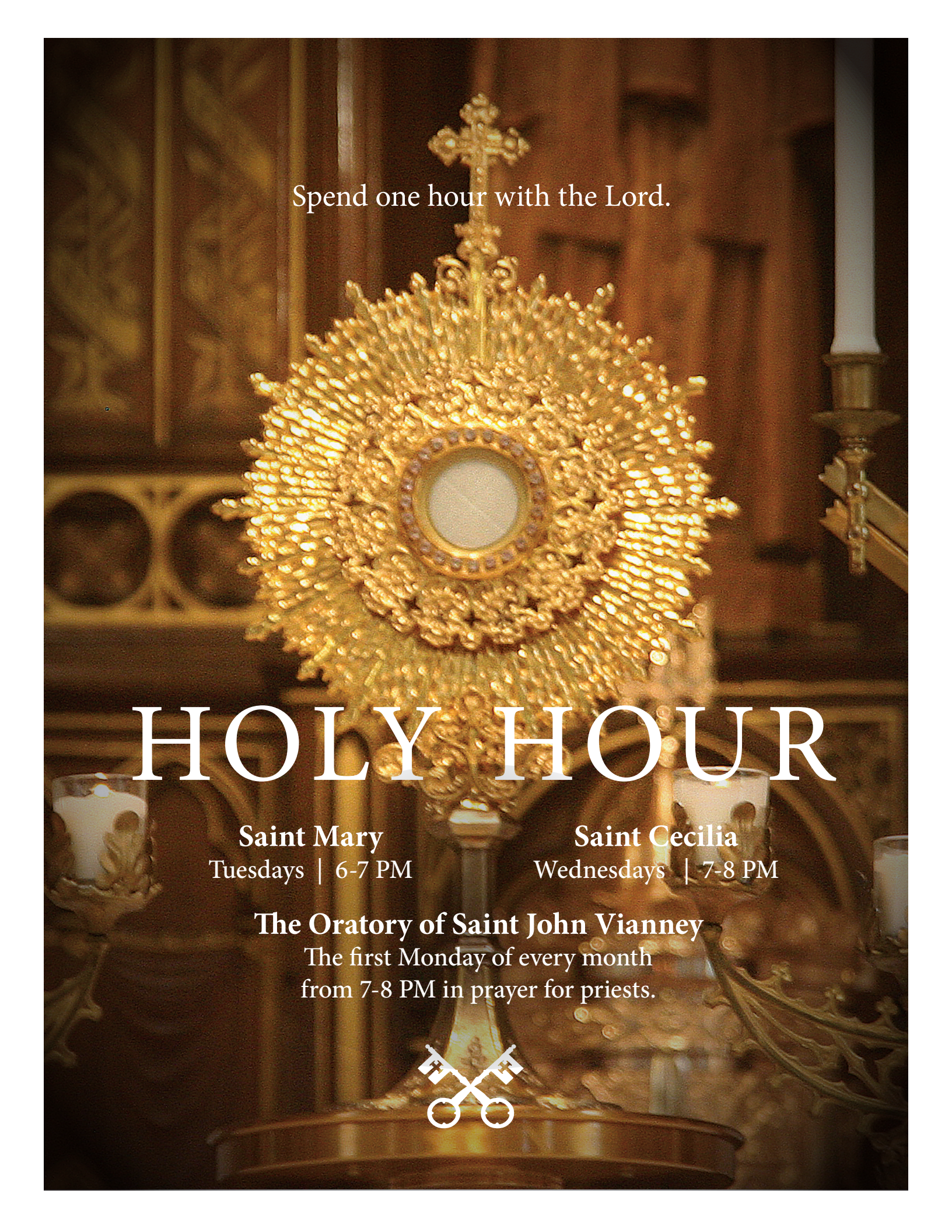

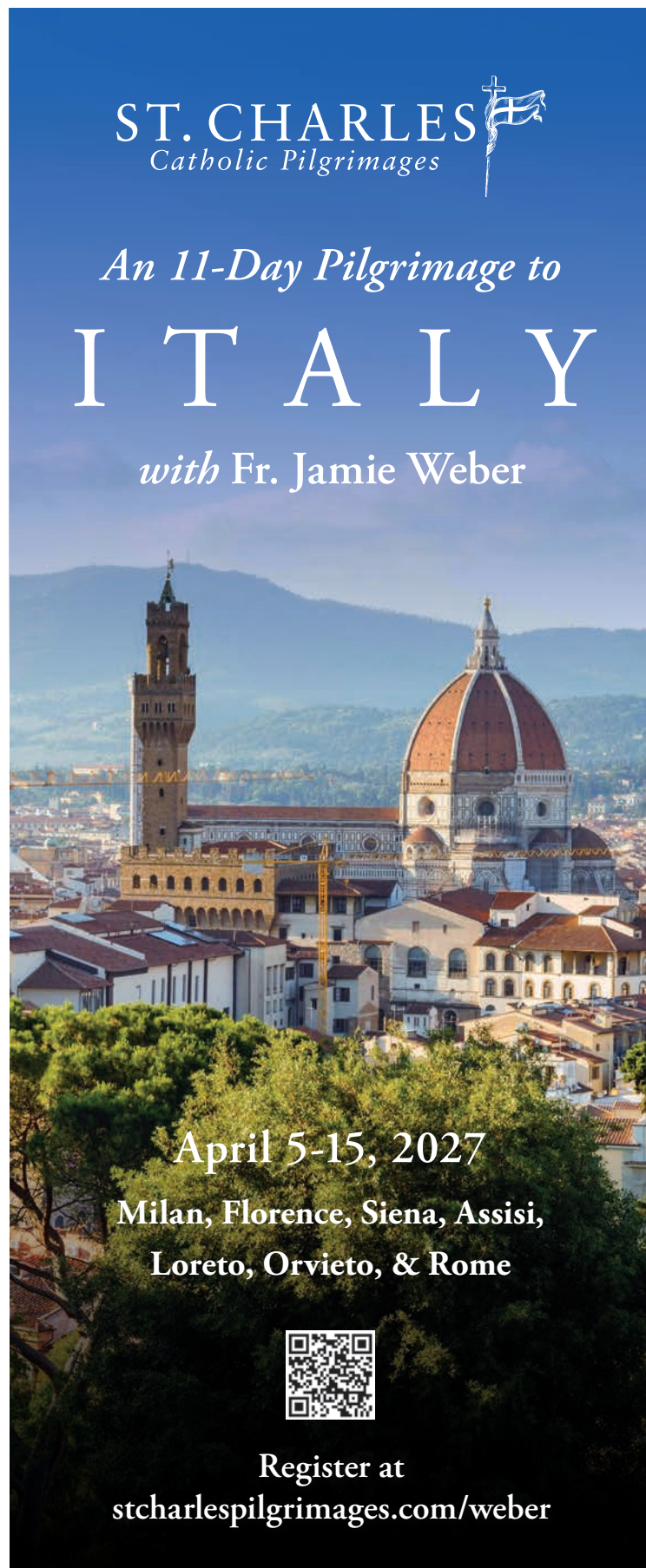

Celebrate Your Jubilee Wedding Anniversary with Archbishop Casey

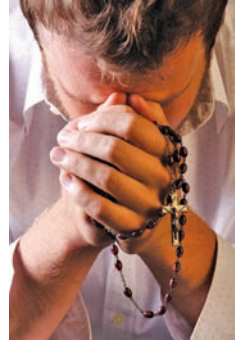

Patient Grace

Have you ever planted a garden only to find weeds growing alongside the flowers or vegetables you carefully tended? Our first instinct is often to pull the weeds immediately. Yet in this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus tells a surprising parable. The master instructs his servants to let the wheat and weeds grow together until the harvest, trusting that the good will ultimately prevail.

Stewardship invites us to see ourselves in that field.

God has planted incredible gifts within each of us—our time, our talents, our resources, and our capacity to love. Those gifts don't grow in perfect conditions. Life is messy. We face setbacks, distractions, doubts, and imperfections. Yet God doesn't give up on us. As the Book of Wisdom reminds us, He is "merciful and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in kindness." His patience creates room for growth.

That same patience should shape the way we live as disciples. Stewardship is not about perfection before participation. It's about faithfully offering what we have today, trusting that God will continue His work in us. Every act of generosity, every hour volunteered, every prayer offered, every invitation extended, and every gift shared becomes another seed planted in God's Kingdom.

Jesus also compares the Kingdom to a tiny mustard seed and a small measure of yeast. Neither seems impressive at first, yet both quietly transform everything around them. The same is true of faithful stewardship. A simple act of kindness, a commitment to weekly Mass, consistent sacrificial giving, or welcoming someone new to our parish family may seem small in the moment, but God uses these ordinary offerings to accomplish extraordinary things.

This week, ask yourself: **What seed is God asking me to plant?** Don't worry about how large it seems. Simply entrust it to the Lord, who alone brings growth.

As good stewards, we are called not only to bear fruit ourselves but also to trust God's patient work in others. **Together, through countless small acts of faithfulness, we become the harvest He has prepared.**

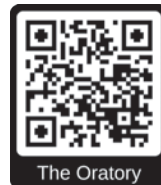
