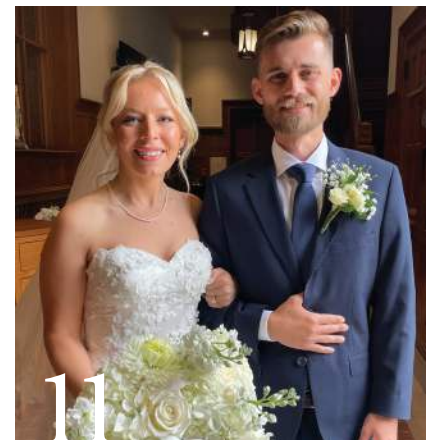
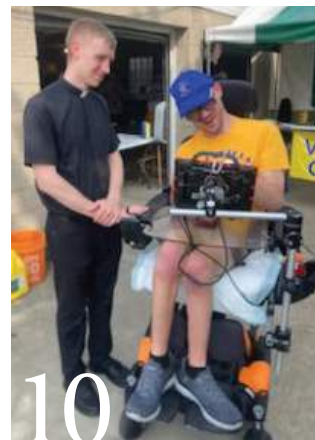

Family of Faith equips parents to embrace their role as the primary catechists through monthly classes. The rest of the instruction occurs in the home. **Registrations are now live for the 2026-2027 school year. 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Marriage Solutions

If you are having trouble within your marriage, especially if you are considering separation, the Church is here to help you. There is no such thing as Catholic divorce, as marriage is a permanent, unbreakable institution. Even if you think you and your spouse are beyond all reconciliation, there is hope and there is help. Even if you are separated or civilly divorced, your marriage bond is not broken. **Please reach out to Deacon Nathan (deaconnathan@stceciliacincinnati.org) for a confidential meeting.** Our clergy will assist you or guide you to someone who can.

However, there are times when two people have attempted marriage invalidly, have separated, and are in need of the Church's help in order to marry in the future. Catholics who are in this state do not need to refrain from the Sacraments unless they have already attempted marriage again or are in a relationship with a person other than their spouse. If you suspect your prior marriage may be invalid, we can help with the annulment process. **Email annulment@eastsideregion.org or call 513-321-1207 or 513-871-5757, ext. 222. Deacon Chris Bergman or Deacon John Schuler will get back to you.** All inquiries regarding your current or past marriage are kept in the strictest confidence.



Listening for His Voice

Our world is filled with **noise**—busy schedules, constant notifications, endless demands, and countless voices competing for our attention. Amid all the distractions, it can be difficult to recognize the voice of God.

The prophet Elijah expected God to appear in dramatic ways: **the wind, the earthquake, and the fire.** Instead, God came in **a tiny whispering sound.** It was only when Elijah listened that he recognized the Lord's presence.

Peter's experience in the Gospel reminds us that **hearing God's voice is only the beginning.** When Jesus said, "Come," Peter stepped out of the boat. As long as his eyes remained fixed on Christ, he walked on the water. When he focused on the wind and waves, fear took over. Yet even then, Jesus immediately reached out His hand.

Stewardship begins by listening and continues by responding. God still speaks—not only in prayer, but through Scripture, the needs of others, opportunities to serve, and the quiet promptings of the Holy Spirit. The question is not whether God is calling. The question is **whether we are listening.**

This week, make space to hear His voice. Spend a few extra minutes in prayer. Sit quietly before the Blessed Sacrament. Read the Sunday Gospel again. Then ask, **"Lord, where are You inviting me to trust You more?"**

God rarely shouts. He whispers. And when we listen with open hearts and respond with faith, we discover that His hand is always there to lead us.

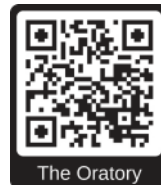
