There's Room at the Table

One of the greatest gifts we can offer another person is **the assurance that they belong.**

In this Sunday's readings, God reminds us that **His invitation is for everyone.** Through the prophet Isaiah, the Lord promises that His house "shall be called **a house of prayer for all peoples.**" St. Paul proclaims that God's mercy extends to all. And in the Gospel, Jesus praises the remarkable faith of the Canaanite woman—a person many would have considered an outsider.

Her persistence reminds us that **faith is not measured by where we come from, but by our willingness to trust in Christ.**

Stewardship calls us to reflect God's generous welcome. Every smile offered to a visitor, every invitation to Mass, every act of kindness, every ministry that makes room for another person helps reveal the heart of God.

Our parish family is strongest when people encounter more than a building—**they encounter a community where they are seen, known, and loved.** Hospitality isn't simply something we do; it is an expression of Christian stewardship.

This week, ask yourself: **Who might be longing for an invitation?** A neighbor, a coworker, a family member, or someone sitting alone at Mass may simply be waiting for someone to notice them.

When we make room for others, we reflect the heart of Christ. God's table is wide enough for everyone, and He invites each of us to help others find their place at it.
