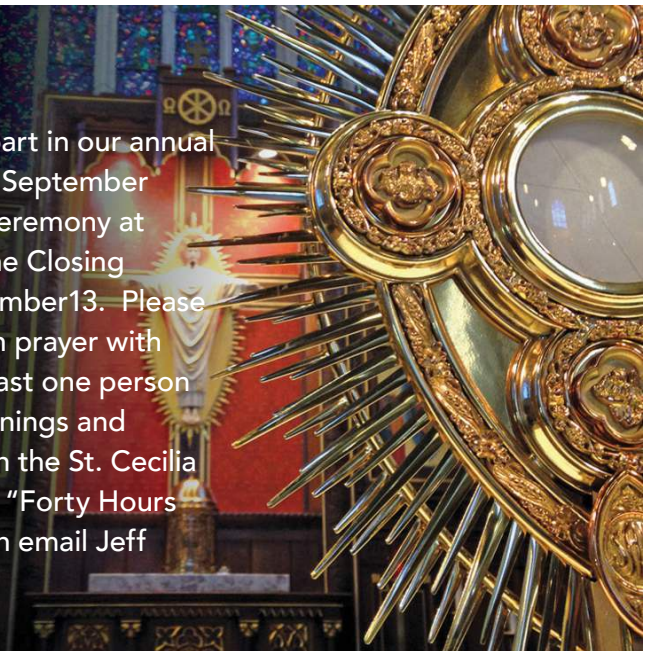

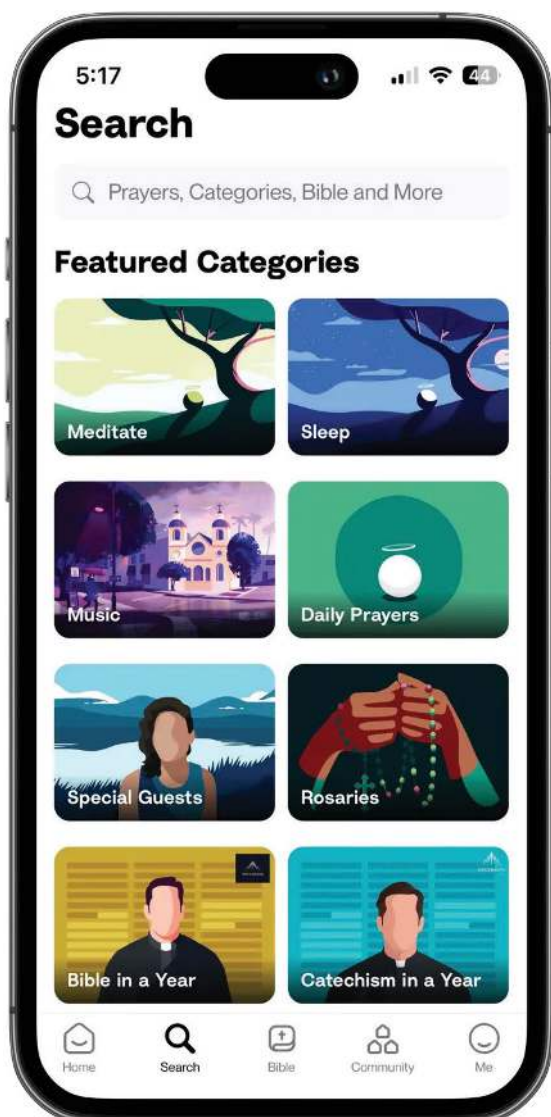

Family of Faith equips parents to embrace their role as the primary catechists through monthly classes. 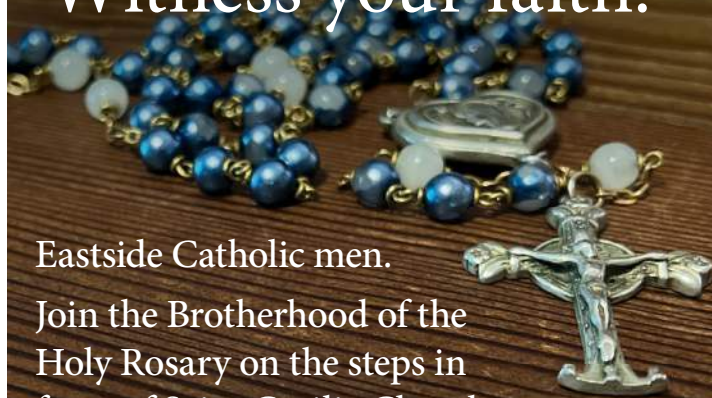

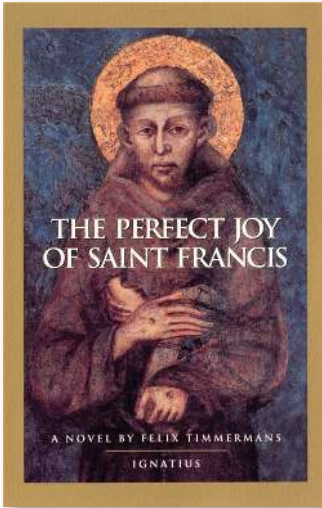

A Personal Answer

Jesus asks His disciples a question that echoes through every generation: **"Who do you say that I am?"**

It isn't a question that can be answered by public opinion or someone else's faith. It is deeply personal. Peter responds, **"You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."** His answer becomes the foundation upon which Jesus builds His Church.

Stewardship begins with that same personal encounter. **Before God asks us to give, He invites us to believe.** When we recognize Jesus as Lord, everything else begins to change. Our time, talents, and resources are no longer simply our own—they become gifts entrusted to us for His mission.

In the first reading, God entrusts Eliakim with responsibility and authority to serve His people. In the Gospel, Jesus entrusts Peter with the keys to the Kingdom. Throughout Scripture, **God calls ordinary people to extraordinary responsibility.** He continues to do the same today.

Each of us has been entrusted with unique gifts, opportunities, and relationships that no one else can offer in quite the same way. Whether through prayer, service, generosity, or simply sharing our faith with others, **we help build the Church one faithful "yes" at a time.**

This week, spend a few moments in prayer with Jesus' question: **"Who do you say that I am?"** Then consider a second question: **"If He truly is the Christ, how is He inviting me to live differently?"**

A personal faith always leads to a purposeful life. When we answer Christ with our hearts, our lives become part of the foundation He continues to build.
